

Condolence Meeting was held on 15th Sept. 2022

The meeting on 15th September 2022 was a special meeting confined to

condolence messages by Rotarians, in memory of Late PP Bishan Mohan Agarwal. PE Feroz Ali, chairing the meeting in the absence of President Manoranjan tripathi I.G. (Retd.), described him a dynamic personality whose memories will linger, for a long time.

PDG Ranbir Singh, reminiscing about Bishan Bhai, referred to him as a simple, soft spoken and smart Rotarian from the reputed family of "Pooran Chand and Sons'. PDG Ranbir Singh related those fond memories of the early seventies, when, as a Rotaractor, he had the opportunity of attending several Rotaract



meetings in Bishan Mohanji's house, where Bishan ji played a perfect host. Though a Rotarian, he acted as a guide and mentor to Rotaractors for many years and under his guidance, Rotaractors undertook many projects.



As a Rotarian, Bishan Bhai took active part in rotary activities and as a leader took prompt and correct decisions in the interest of Rotary. Moreover, he had the ability to influence others with his convincing opinions on any issue, a trait which rated him as an intellectual. His contribution towards the welfare of the society was immense. So much so, that his shop, "M/s Pooran Chand and Sons", was referred to as the headquarters of Rotary Mussoorie, where you engrossed in find Rotarians serious discussions on how to solve problems faced by the town people. The decisions arrived at, were implemented for the well being of the citizens. Such was his commitment towards Rotary and towards the citizens of Mussoorie

Winding up these fond memories, PDG Ranbir Singh felt that the most appropriate tribute to our departed Rtn. Late Bishan Mohan Bhai would be to follow his ideals of commitment to Rotary.

PP Suresh Agarwal expressed his feelings by saying

PP Manmohan Karanwal spoke on a similar vein about our dear Bishan Bhai, whom he had known as a 12 year old child. Apart from Rotary, Bishan ji was involved in numerous social activities and organizations. Himself a very good badminton player; Manmohan ji informed how Bishan Bhai encouraged young sportsmen to form The Mussoorie Sports Association. He was actively involved in conducting tournaments in Badminton, Carom, Cricket, etc. and by conducting such tournaments, the standard of games improved considerably. Bishanji was an elegant skater and his silken smooth skating movements, were a treat to watch.

PAG Shaillendra Karanwal was equally expressive in conveying his sentiments about Bishan Bhai whom he remembered being called as "Sankat Mochan" for his ability to find a solution to any problem. It was Bishanji who motivated Rtn. Shaillendra to join Rotaract and subsequently graduate to Rotary Mussoorie. One striking quality which Rtn. Shaillendra remembered was the manner in which Bishan ji would resolve differences.

PAG Aalak Mehrotra, couldn't come for this special meeting but sent a message which was read out by PAG Vipul Mittal. He termed Bishanji's demise as colossal loss for Rotary Mussoorie. He was a person who despite the age difference, difference in social status and the class, would easily gel with the youngsters and make them feel at home. Aalok ji remembered the days when

Bishanji's family home, The Garden Reach Estate was a second home to youngsters like him. That was the time, in late sixties and early seventies, when he came in contact with Bishan Bhai who introduced him into the Rotary world through Interact, Rotaract and finally Rotary. It was through his insistence and inspiration that an Interact Club was setup in RN Bhargav Inter College. It was his amiable style that motivated youngsters in Rotary to climb up the hierarchal ladder in Rotary. His in-depth knowledge, sincere advice given along with periodic laughter instilled confidence in everyone who came into contact with him. He will always be remembered as lovable Rotarian who rendered distinguished service to Rotary Mussoorie.

Among the younger generation of Rotarians; Rtn. Sandeep Sahni referred to "Bishan Uncle" as a father figure. He said that he spent a lot of time, specially while returning from school, at Bishanji's residence, the Garden Reach, where Lata aunty (Bishanji's lady wife) would serve snacks and milk. He remembered the days when his dad bought an Ambassador car and both families went on a trip to Rajasthan. He remembered the days when Bishanji taught him the nuances of Billiards, Snooker and Pool.

There were many other speakers who wanted to convey their thought; but time constraints prevented them to voice their sentiments. All speakers made special mention of Bishanji's charming lady wife Lataji, who was a perfect home maker and was always with him, be it The Skating Rink, the evening stroll along the Mall or at other social gatherings. Ann Lata ji will always continue to be a member of our Rotary Mussoorie family and all Rotarians will be at her beck and call, whenever required.

Bishan Bhai's nephew, PP Nitish Mohan Aggarwal was the closest to him and could not overcome his emotions, when asked to speak.

The common sentiment for Bishan Bhai was that his amicable nature, charm and poise were qualities to be emulated by one and all.


