She spoke very well on the subject explaining about sub-specialties in ophthalmology using advanced laser machines and latest technologies.

She explained about various eye diseases and mainly cataract and its treatments using laser and use of robots in surgery, importance of mechanized process vis a vis needs of manual operations. She answered a number of questions asked by members present. Dr. Vijay Sabharwal MD. (AIIMS), DO (Dublin) was also in the meeting and also answered various questions of members. Overall it was very informative and we came out confident that our eyes can be well cared in all age groups ranging from routine examination to complex operations even replacement of eye lenses.
