Distt. Conference & Governors Election for the year 2025-26

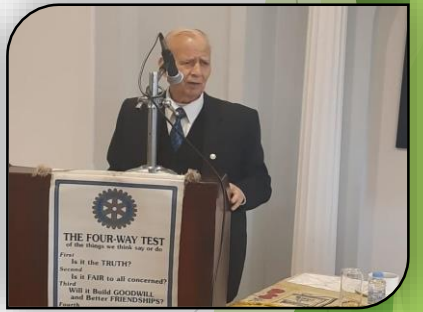

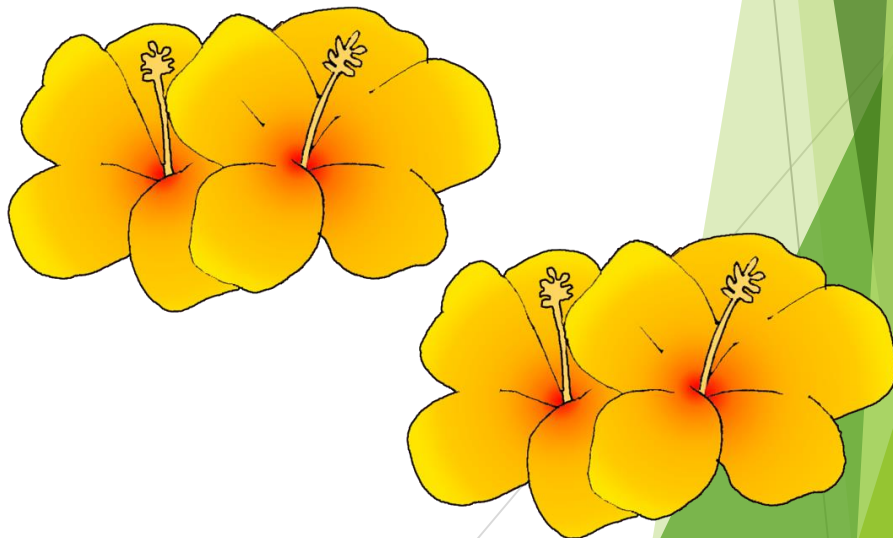
