

About us

An affiliate of Rotary International, the *Rotary Club of Delhi Garden City* was chartered in 1989. One of the most active Rotary Clubs in the Delhi/NCR area, its members represent a wide cross-section of society and include prominent citizens, ambassadors, diplomats, industrialists, private businessmen, educationists, professionals from legal, healthcare, hospitality, social & public services, information technology, etc.

The primary mission of the Rotary Club of Delhi Garden City is

'To promote children's health & education'



<u>Basti Vikas Kendra – Srinivaspuri</u>

- Started in 1999, daily labourers leave their 3-6year old children in the Balwadi for a full day's care where we provide primary education, mid-day meal, uniforms, toys, medical checkups etc.
- The batch comprises of 50-60 students every year from nearby slum areas
- The Club meets all the expenses involved for teachers, maids/cooks as well as teaching supplies and sports good for children and infrastructure improvement.







Skill Development- Sewing Centres

- Our Club is running three Sewing and Tailoring training centres in association with Singer India Ltd. Two of these are running for almost 6-7 years. The third one is two years old.
- The centres are located in Noida, South Ex and Gurugram
- A Diploma certificate is provided by Singer after six months of training to the women in the economically weaker section of society, so that woman can earn their livelihood.
- The Centres train every year about 40-45 girls of upto 18 years of age.
- We have also started training them on Industrial Sewing machines to make them ready for employment, if they choose to seek that.
- Besides, sewing, we are also training them on spoken English and work related behaviour.
- Recurring expenses for these centres is about Rs 3.5 lacs/year. The machines are donated by our members. The place is contributed by our member at one location, by another NGO at second location. The third one is on rent.



Skill Development- IT Skills

- The Club started an IT skills development Center at Rani Bagh, Delhi. It has 10 computers donated by one of our member
- It trains upto 30 students in three batches with the basic computer skills including the Microsoft office bouquet.
- The place is provided by another NGO.
- The annual expense is about Rs 2lacs per year besides the maintenance of machines.





Happy School - MCD School, Srinivaspuri

- This 550 students Girls School was assigned to RCDGC by the Municipal Corporation of Delhi in 2011 to improve governance.
- In the last ten years the school has the club has done major infrastructure renovation and today is a model "Happy School" for all Rotary Clubs in the NCR-region.
- RCDGC has renovated interiors (4 Floors, 27 Classrooms) including painting, repair of electrical fittings and fixtures, installation of notice boards, a new stage construction and murals painted in Assembly Hall.
- Set up a new library, a computer lab, an arts/craft room, a science lab and a medical room.
- Upgraded toilets as well as constructed one for the handicapped.
- Provided a complete water filtration plant to ensure clean drinking water for the children and teachers. These units do not contain chemicals or use electricity.
- Installed 3 Hand Wash Stations with 24 taps each on Ground Floor & 1st Floor.

Wins & WasH in Schools

- Provided hand-wash stations and toilets in 27 MCD Schools
- Since 2013, we have renovated 255 toilets; 62 Urinals & 345 Hand-wash stations in 27 schools, benefitting life of more than 28000 students.
- The Club incurs Maintenance & upkeep expenditure of Rs. 5.00 lacs p.a. now.







Clean Drinking Water in MCD Schools

- Another hallmark project undertaken in 2016-17 was to provide clean drinking water to the children.
- Club have installed Water Filtration plants in 10 schools benefitting over 11,000 children and staff at the cost of Rs. 55 lacs.
- These water filtration plants are being maintained by the Club under AMC.
- AMC/ Maintenance/ Running Expenses Rs. 11.00 lacs p.a.





Club Foot Surgery

- St Stephens Hospital, civil lines, Delhi has one of the biggest and most successful charitable club foot surgery program.
- Our club has been associated with this since 2014 supporting with annual contribution for meeting the running expenses.
- Club has so far donated Rs. 16.25 lacs for this project
- Equal amount contributed by St. Stephens Patients Welfare Association





Set up Paediatric Covid ward

• At the height of Covid in 2021, Club supported setting up Paediatric Covid Ward with purchase of "Multi-Modality Monitors and "Syringe Pumps" with an expenditure of Rs 6lacs

Corrective Surgery for Polio Victims

• To reduce the disability arising from childhood musculoskeletal problems including paralytic poliomyelitis, we provide financially help to economically weak children to undergo surgery, physiotherapy and rehabilitation at the Hospital.

Project Prakash - Dr Shroff's Charitable Eye Hospital

 Project Prakash: has been working since 2013 for strengthening vision care through treatment of Vision impairments including Congenial Eye surgeries of children who are suffering from blindness since birth, cataract surgeries, etc. Has spent Rs 15 lacs for this project and contributed to improving vision care for about 150 children. Over this period.





Annual Inter School Debating Competition

- We are into 13th year of organizing Annual Inter School Debate Competition in association with our Interact club of 'Kulachi Hansraj Model School. It has become the most awaited program for the Schools. For past two years, due to covid disturbances, it was a very successfully run as an Online Debate.
- Elite schools from India & Abroad participate in the competition and debates are conducted on Asian Parliamentary principles.



PROJECTS EXECUTED IN LAST FEW YEARS

Paediatric Cancer

- We have done this project under Global Grant for Rs. 32.64 lacs
- Out of 66 patients undertaken for the treatment, 19 children went into remission cycle and 12 children went into maintenance cycle

Hepatitis 'B' & 'C'

- Successfully undertaken awareness and vaccination of Hepatitis 'B' to the children in the age group of 6 to 17 years in the year 2011 under Matching Grant benefitting 15,000 children.
- Undertaken yet another project named 'Project Surajmukhi' in 2019 for awareness and screening for Hepatitis 'C'. Have done screening of 5,600 children in the slums and high-risk areas. The project cost was Rs. 11.50 lacs.





PROJECTS EXECUTED IN LAST FEW YEARS

- <u>Strengthen Dialysis ward of Rotary Blood Bank</u>
 - RCDGC donated Two Dialysis Machines to Rotary Dialysis Centre at Rotary Blood Bank – Gurugram.
- <u>Upgrading Paediatric Covid ward at ESI Hospital</u>
 - Donated "Neo puff Machine" for Neonatal ICU and "Infusion Pumps" (Two in Number), to ESI Hospital, Jhilmil Colony to be used for COVID patients in the Paediatric COVID-19 ward.
- <u>Covid Vaccination Camps</u>
 - We held 3 Covid Vaccination Camps and administered 3012 jabs in association with Hope Oncology Clinic and Learning by Locals.
