Honesty



Rotaract Club of DTU Regency in collaboration with Leo Club, UoD organized an E-Waste Collection Campaign Drive on campus from 3rd February to 8th February, wherein 20+ council members volunteered to collect e-waste.

The club members collected different types of E-waste from the college students like wires, earphones, data cables, WIFI routers, etc. About 100+ students participated, and about 10 kgs of e-waste was collected.
