In keeping with this noble belief, the club contributed USD 30,000 to the Rotary Foundation last year.

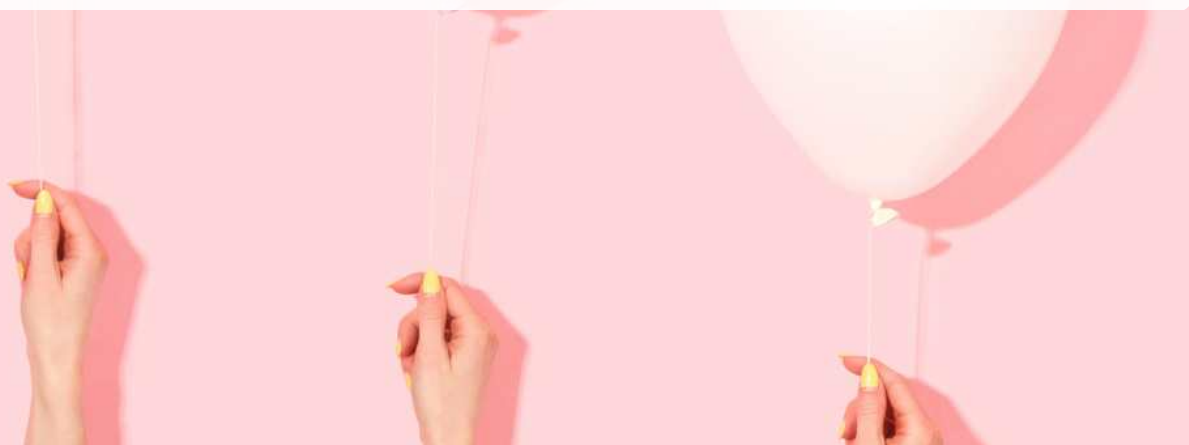
