Multidisciplinary Free Health Camp RCD- RIDGE organised the Multidisciplinary Free Health Camp with Fortis Hospital and in collaboration with IWC VasantKunj, and NITRD on 23rd July at Saptarishi P School, Chattarpur. Multidisciplinary camp attended by 100 patients. There were Dental check, Eye check, Bone density check, blood sugar BP Ortho doctor, Gynae-doctor on duty. The TB van introduced in service with Rotary clubs associated by Rtn Dr K Chopra was also available in service- more than 35 patients were X-rayed & checked by the specialist from NITRD. The Camp was coordinated by UBA under Deshbandu College & also visited by Zone12 AG Rtn A Rungta & Rtn Chand Malhotraji.





Eye check organized by RCD-RIDGE President for the EWS children of the Bharti Public School, Swasthya Vihar. Was held at 0900am on 26th July with support of Rtn Namrata Suri Dist.3011 with Vision Spring of USAID. The Children are gifted with a pencil box and masks for use. and give Free spectacles for the school children of the under privileged class.
