He has acquired over 25 heritage properties and converted them into heritage hotels after restoration. Mr. Nath has published several illustrated books on Rajasthan and Indian arts. During conversation he talked about Neemrana Jaipur. He explained how the Fort was Built since 1464, abandoned in 1947, acquired in 1986, this splendid ruin restored into an exquisite resort near Delhi. He also Narrated two interesting stories on Lord Shiva.

## PDG Suresh Jain



Our Dear Suresh ji , visited this planet Earth from 30th May 1940 - 23rd July 2022 and touched the lives of Millions of people. He was a self made man, who strived with sweat and blood to take the Jain Family to this unique position. He was always a family man, who believed in the old world charm of family values, be it his parents, siblings, wife and children. He was an enigma for the uninitiated and a dear friend for his associates!

With his always ready to help nature, he became a true Rotarian, immediately on being inducted in the Club in 1980 itself. Entrusted with the responsibility of FUND RAISING, he organised the Pankaj Udhas night at the Siri Fort Auditorium, Khel Gaon Marg, in New Delhi, which he had constructed for the 1982 Asian Games.

The true Rotarian spirit rose to newer heights in his Governorship year, wherein he had the Installation of all District 3010 Presidents at the Talkatora Stadium in New Delhi , at the same time.

His biggest challenge was to create institutions for Rotarians to make an impact in the society. Under his able leadership, the Rotary Blood Bank was set up in Tughlakabad , of which he was the incumbent Chairman. This penchant for Rotary institutions helped set up the Rotary Habitat Centre in Pushp Vihar too.

This passion was very infectious, so as to inspire him to set up a Social Club- The Holiday Club for his fellow residents of Panchsheel Enclave in New Delhi.

This ability of his, enabled him to set up another service institution in the memory of his beloved wife, Usha ji -The Rotary Diabetes Centre , established on 24th May, in memory of Usha ji , who had passed away due to Diabetes in 2014. The Centre has been setup on their privately owned property in Bhawani Kunj, Vasant Kunj New Delhi. The Centre has been a must visit for many visiting Rotary dignitaries. PRIP Kalyan Bannerjee, PRIP Gary Huang, PRIP Ron Burton and all RIPRs alongwith all the visiting Polio Teams, as it's a Polio NID Centre too. The centre has state of the art facilities which are available for all of us to put





to good use for the betterment of the Community. Rotary Diabetes Centre has conducted more than 1500 Diabetes Screening Camps over the last 7 years. The Rotary Foundation has always been very dear to him!

In fact, on 1st July 2016, at the Installation of President Sudip Kohli, at a Service Project in a Girls School in New Delhi, which happened to be the Centennial Year of the Rotary Foundation, he announced his intention to become an Arch Klump Society (AKS) Member, contributing US\$ 250,000/-. This spirit of giving, in fact, inspired the whole Club to follow and the Club became a 100% PHF Club contributing a total of US\$ 150,000/- in that year itself, the highest in the District!

He went on to join the next level of Trustee Chair Circle, pledging for US\$ 500,000/-. This figure has reached upto US\$ 365,000/- till now.

The father figure of our Club, who had fought many a battle with respiratory diseases many a times, sometimes on foreign soil too, with his never say die spirit fought valiantly for 5-6 months and left for his heavenly abode with many a task unfinished, giving us a chance to be inspired by his philanthropic journey to finish them. Setting up a State Of The Art facility for Preventative Blindness being one of the top priorities.

Let's all live up to his ideals and work on the path of DOING GOOD IN THE WORLD, inspired by him!

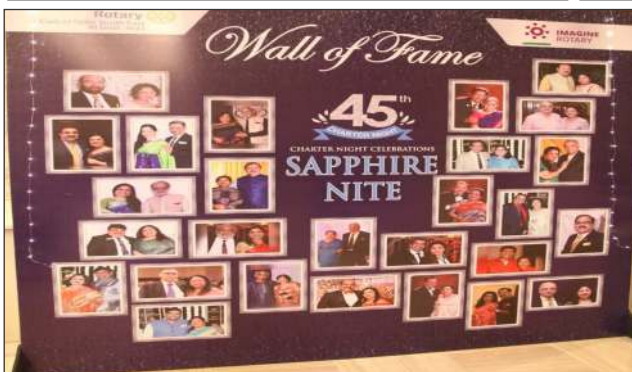

## Environment Walk - Dec 25th



"Mangar Bani - ancient sacred grove"

Making peace with Nature is the defining task of the 21st Century, says United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) report. To do so one has to learn and explore nature. That may be the motto behind the Environment Walk organized by Rotary, Delhi South East on 25th December 2022.

The programme started with the participants in the Walk - 29 in all - assembling at Hotel Lalit Mangar in the chilly morning of Christmas. We then moved in limited number of vehicles to Mangar Bani base. The idea was to minimize the disturbance to the flora and fauna by the vehicular movement. Mangar Bani, which is one of the oldest preserved forest in Delhi NCR on the border of Delhi and Gurgaon has been well preserved by the local villagers of Mangar and Bandhwari treating it as sacred grove.

There we met Mr Sunil Harsana, a grassroots Environmentalist and Wildlife Conservationist, also known as Pied Piper of Mangar and Mr. Chetan Agarwal - a known Environmental Researcher. Well guided by him, we went round the Forest where it is said that the plants are never uprooted or harmed. Away from din and bustle of the urban life it was a good learning about our surroundings, theory of survival of fittest, mutual interdependence between plants and animals and above all our eco system. The forest had number of Check Dams build by the Eco Club members for properly utilizing the water streams.

After an exhilarating walk in the forest, we moved to Aman Bagh - an ecological and organic farm. We were treated here with mouth-watering delicacies such as "Sarson da Saag and Makke di Roti" and "Bajare ki Roti with Kari Pakori". Reddish and Carrot fresh from the farm added another flavour to the sumptuous Brunch.

This was followed by the Power Point presentation made by Mr Harsana and Agrawal with their team depicting the change in Aravalli Range in last 4-5 years and how there has been an improvement in water table recharge and forest coverage. The event was very well Coordinated by Rtn. Anupama Kohli.
