The global grant was received from Rotary International in RY 2022-23, and thereafter steps were taken to execute this project. A committee was formed under the leadership of PP Rtn. Mukesh Agarwal along with PP Rtn. Ajeet Jalan. In the month of November 2022, an order was placed for purchase of "Chassis, Ashok Leyland". We are delighted to inform you that we have received the custom chassis and the next step of body making has been initiated.

We are hopeful that all activities related to this project will be completed in this year itself and the Cancer Detection Van will become operational in RY 2022-23.









3 February-Free Cancer Screening Camp

A camp to clinically examine breasts by way of a pap smear and an oral check up was held on 3rd February at Arya Samaj Mandir, Vasant Kunj. The camp was put up in association with Rajiv Gandhi Cancer Institute and Research Centre, Niti Bagh and Samagraa.

A mammography van is used for the purpose. It goes to the doorsteps of women living in slums/villages/urban areas. Mammograms can be used to check for breast cancer in women who have no signs or symptoms of the disease. This helps in timely detection of breast cancer at an early stage, thereby saving lives of many.
