multiple fronts, and build the spirit of Rotary within our Rotary family. We have gotten off to a wonderful start.

Trees and Solar power are our club's focus areas towards a greener world. Our flagship project of installing solar plants and panels took off with successful installation of solar panels and solar lights at Donate an Hour (DoAR) NGO through CSR contributions from IGT Solutions. Solar panels have become enabler for the 49 children staying at the DoAR campus to be able to carry out their education through online classes with remote teachers.

With the goal of caring for specially-abled and making them self-sufficient, our club's second flagship project for the current RY '**Donate A Limb'** - was launched jointly with Rotary Divyang Kendra, Delhi. In our first camp we provided prosthetic limbs and calipers to the needy. We plan to hold series of camps through the year to target total 100 beneficiaries.

Keeping up with our tradition of giving, our members contributed and participated in multiple service projects - donation of cleaning supplies, distribution of women hygiene products, eatables & fruits at a labor camp, donation of science books at NGO DoAR, screening of middle school children for preventable blindness.

Patriotism was in the air in the month of August. Club organized flags for members who in turn very proudly shared their pictures with Tiranga at their homes. It was a visual treat to see the collage of our members with the National Flag.

September is basic education and literacy month. As true Rotarians we need to work towards Rotary's goal of strengthening the communities to support basic education and literacy, reduce gender disparity in education, and support education for all children.

For children to receive a healthy education, their environment must be healthy as well. Our club has been contributing to improving the infrastructure at multiple government schools and plans to continue the same this year. Building toilet blocks for girl students, wash stations to maintain hygienic conditions in schools, distribution of stationary, and uniforms are some activities through which we plan to do our bit for education and literacy.


