Another proud moment for our club was when the two 20 KW solar plants installed by our club through CSR funding at NGO Earth Saviours Foundation were inaugurated by DG Rtn Ashok Kantoor. The erratic power availability during extreme weather conditions was making life difficult for residents living at Sewa Dham. Safety issues at night were additional challenges being faced by them. The new solar plants will fulfill their needs as they will power each residential unit fully for lights, fans, medical equipment and other devices.

This was second large solar project for our club this year. Previously, a solar plant was setup at NGO DoAr in rural area of Gurgaon. Setting up solar plants for NGOs in the remote is a step towards making them self-reliant while also saving the environment. Solar energy, a renewable source of energy will not only reduce their Carbon footprint but will also save on electricity bills in the long run.

Our club's initiative in supporting environment projects which are directly impacting lives of underprivileged children and abandoned senior citizens and mentally challenged persons has been a very fulfilling and satisfying journey.

Earth Saviours Foundation, Mandawar

Inauguration of 2x20 KW Solar Plants with IGT Solutions Pvt Ltd.

A truly historic day. Our club's flagship project and the largest till date, the Solar Plants, at Mandawar shelter of the Earth Saviours Foundation for abandoned senior citizens and mentally challenged persons was inaugurated by DG Rtn Ashok Kantoor. The simple ceremony was attended by Mr. Jas Kalra, Director – ESF, Rotary District Team Members, sponsors IGT Solutions' Officials and a large number of club members and ESF Staff.

DG was very appreciative of our project for helping the not so fortunate fellow human beings and applauded the presence of our members in large numbers to support the cause. Each solar plant that we have installed will power one double storey shelter



home housing around 100-125 people to operate all the electrical points / gadgets and medical equipment. Two plants will impact almost 220-250 lives directly. This project was accomplished by raising CSR funds to the tune of 24 Lakhs from IGT Solutions Pvt. Ltd. The officials from the company present in the function were presented a GRATITUDE TROPHY,

Speaker Session- "The SevenCircles of Dharma"-Rtn PP Ashok Thussu




What followed after the Club meeting was a very enlightening and enriching session by our member Rtn PP Ashok Thussu who talked about his book

"The Seven Circles of Dharma" and how the philosophy behind could be used to improve the quality of our lives by improving the correctness or quality of our decisions and actions.




Rtn Thussu explained briefly that our day-to-day decisions and actions practically every moment of the day are based on what we feel is right at that particular moment. In India we often say, Dharam ka palan karo (inculcate and follow the way of Dharma). However, the dilemma is always to figure out the right actions as we strain to live or walk the correct path.



The "Seven Circles of Dharma" divides Dharma in seven circles with "SELF" as the first, innermost circle, surrounded by 6 more around it representing the degree of our priority or relationship with other factors or people. The last circle is the "WORLD". It is a secure way for any person to live a worthwhile, ethical and fulfilling life and a powerful NEW method of Personal Leadership that allows us to be intuitively fair in our thoughts and actions.

The consequence of action is key and is often ignored in fast and complex environments as we do not have the right frame of reference to judge and don't know the method to do this quickly. Rtn Thussu's book will empower us with an amazingly easy to follow secret process that shows us how to do this and act with a quilt free mind.

It is Dharma – the correct way of thinking and resulting action that WE can master for greater mental peace.
