

### **Rotary India Literacy Mission**



The Rotary India Literacy Mission (RILM), formerly known as Rotary South Asia Society for Development and Cooperation (RSAS) aims to work towards Total literacy and Quality Education in India. To achieve that RILM have designed a comprehensive program called "T-E-A-C-H" where:

- T Teacher Support
- E E-learning
- A Adult Literacy
- C Child Development
- H Happy School

Each of these programs has a specific focus and it is interlinked with each other in achieving the common goal of bringing total literacy and improving the learning outcomes of primary education, in various parts of the country.

# **The Teacher Support Program**


The aim of the Teacher Support program is to improve the professional skills and performance of teachers.

Activities Under this program are,

1. Training / Retraining of teachers

Training/Re-training instils confidence and strengthens skills in teachers which eventually lead to better performance in everyday classroom; it also reinforces teachers' content knowledge and improves the learning outcome of the students.





**Achievements**: RILM have successfully trained 1,80,707 teachers with the proactive role of Rotary clubs around the country. Apart from training, 36,222 outstanding teachers have been recognised with the Nation Builder Awards.



"E-Shiksha", aims at improving the teaching-learning experience through the use of curriculum based audio-visual modules in local languages in Govt. / Govt. aided schools.

**"E-Shiksha"** is the program is a single classroom installation in Government / aided schools which aims to improve the teaching-learning experience through an integrated solution consisting of a LCD projector / LED TV / Smart LED TV loaded with the educational audio-visual software mapped with State curriculum in local languages. Software content can be offline entrenched in a SD card / pen drive or online rooted to any educational application depending upon the requirement of the project.



**Achievements**: As of now, RILM have successfully installed elearning system in 27,368 government and government-aided schools across the country through Rotary Clubs, CSR and PSU support.









### **Adult Literacy Program**



It aims to impart functional literacy to non-literate adults (15+ age) across India and then engage literate young adults in skill development training through various resource organizations.

Activities under the program:

- 1. Diksha one to one approach In this approach student-volunteers from schools/colleges are engaged in providing functional literacy classes to non-literate adults (15+ age) over a period of 45-60 days.
- 2. Vidya Through partnership with large organizations

There are organizations that have large membership or followers (Example Brahma Kumaries, Rashtriya Sewak Sangh, Association of Muslim Professionals, The Bharat Scouts & Guides and Gayatri Pariwar etc). This approach focuses on building relationship with such organizations and inviting them to be an active partner to achieve the goal of "Total Literacy".

**Achievements**: Under the Adult Literacy program 88,005 adults have been made literate through Diksha and Swabhimaan.





Child Development program of RILM also known as Asha Kiran aims to bring/send back out-of-school children to schools. Under this program children from socially and economically disadvantaged and vulnerable communities, who have never been enrolled at any school or have dropped out from school (or irregular in school), or laggard children are mainstreamed ensuring their retention in schools after required grooming. The objective is to facilitate these children's access to mainstream state funded primary/elementary schools.

**Achievement**: RILM under its flagship program Asha Kiran, have successfully enrolled 44,190 out-of-school children into the program from across 15 states through 34 NGOs.

# **Happy School**

This program aims to provide/upgrade the infrastructural and coscholastic facilities in state funded schools, to make them secure, attractive and happy learning places for students and teachers.

A positive and a cheerful school environment with all basic-infrastructure present can increase student enrolment, yield better attendance which leads to higher retention and improves concentration which leads to better learning outcome among students.

**Achievement**: Since the inception of the TEACH program, RILM have successfully transformed 3,112 government and government-aided schools across the country through Rotary clubs and districts.
