
### **Weekly Project Nutritious Food distribution**

# Avoidable Blindness - Eye Check-up Camp at L.P.Savani Group of Schools

Rotary Club of Surat has always been regularly organizing periodic eye check-up camps at various schools for all ages. The objective of the camp is to spread awareness on eye disorders, early detection of ailments and avoid partial or total blindness.

The 1<sup>st</sup> eye checkup camp was organized at L.P.Savani Academy School, Vesu, Surat in coordination with Inner Wheel Club of Surat. 102 people attended the camp for eye check-up and testing. Here some people were advised for optical correction of glasses.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> eye checkup camp was organized at L.P.Savani Riverside School, Dabholi, Surat. 70 beneficiaries attending the free eye camp were evaluated for vision and eye ailments. 1 patient was identified and advised cataract surgery.

These kind of camps helps to detect ailments of blindness and avoid visual impairment in time.
