Rtn. Prof. Dr. Harish Chauhan is one of the well-known surgeons of Surat city with an experience of more than 24 years as Senior Professor and Consultant, specialist in GI, GI Onco, Bariatric and Laparoscopic versatile critical surgeries. He is passionate and dedicated about his work at SMIMER, Surat. He obtained his medical education from Government Medical College, Surat. He is happily married to Purvi Chauhan, who is Commerce Graduate and Masters in Human Resource Management, a back-bone support to him, a freelancer and a former Banker apart from a stay-at- home parent. The couple is blessed with a son, Khush Chauhan, who is appearing in 10th Board in February 2023.

He joined the Rotary Club of Surat in 2015, with vision to serve the community. He is a PHF. He regularly attends club meetings and has held various positions as chairman at different fronts in our Club. Currently, he is the Polio-Plus Chair of our Club. He was actively involved in distribution of food kits by RC Surat Team during Covid times and has received recognition for his service from SMC and our club. He has attended many medical and health check-up camps at tribal areas, arranged fellow doctors for the medical camps at club and district level, and has attended district conferences since he joined Rotary Club. He extended medical assistance to many members and relatives of our club, other clubs and its members during Covid pandemic crisis.

On the professional front, he is a fellow member of DMAS, FMAS, FBMS, FICP etc. to name a few. He is an all-a-round surgeon with skills and expertise in performing Endoscopies, Uro-surgeries, Plastic-surgeries, Onco-surgeries, Neuro-surgeries, Thoracic-surgeries, Paediatric-surgeries too. He is on the Panel of National Medical Council, India (NMC) and National Accreditation Board of Hospital (NABH) as an auditor, associated with AMASI, IMA, AWRSOC, ASI etc and PG Examiner and Guide. He has performed around 45000 surgeries till date. As a Disaster Nodal Officer at SMIMER, he has served various natural and man-made calamities site at different parts of India, such as Kutch earthquake, Orissa Cyclone, Tsunami at Tamilnadu, Sabarmati train accident, buildings and bridge collapse sites etc, during lock-down period in recent Covid pandemic, he performed around 130 surgeries for service of mankind. He has presented 42 Research publications in the National and International Journal of Surgeries. As a Professor of Surgery he has trained many to be Surgeons under him and have inspired them to carry forward his vision of good surgical skills with high moral values for the benefits of patients and how to make a difference in their lives and society. He has worked with Leelavati Hospital and Tata Cancer Institute, Mumbai. He has trained himself in various Advance Surgical fronts in India from GEMS Institute of GI Surgery (Coimbatore), Mohak Bariatrics (Indore), HCG Institute of Robotics (Bangalore and Ahmedabad) etc and at International level, from Royal King's College of London (U.K.) and Edinburgh (U.K.) and Hidelberg Institute (Germany). He has obtained many Fellowships, Awards and Recognitions from various NGO's, Colleges and Medical Institutes.

Apart from his hobbies of travelling, reading, sports, Rtn. Dr. Harish Chauhan believes in nature conservation, he has planted and taken care of more than 1000 trees at road side, villages, college campus, barren land till they grow sufficiently. He is also actively trying to save species of house sparrows by feeding and taking care of them. The couple loves to explore different corners of the world and has travelled 16 countries for work and leisure.
