Free Eye Check up Camp by RCC Lajpore, Sachin



On the 19th of March 2023, a free eye check-up camp was organized by the RCC Lajpore Sachin in association with Ather Foundation, Samarpan Multispeciality Hospital, Sachin and Rotary Eye Maliba Hospital, Navsari. The aim of the camp was to provide free eye care services to the people living in and around Sachin. The camp was held at the Samarpan Multispeciality Hospital, and around 1000 people were screened for various eye ailments.

The eye check-up camp began at 8:30 am and lasted until 4:00 pm. A team of ophthalmologists, optometrists, and trained volunteers were present at the camp to carry out the screenings. The team conducted various eye tests,

including visual acuity, intraocular pressure, and fundus examination, to identify eye disorders. The screenings revealed that 150 people required cataract surgery.

The camp also provided assistance to those who needed spectacles. Around 600 spectacles were distributed to people who required them. Those who needed cataract surgery will be provided free of cost treatment at Rotary Eye Institute, Navsari.

The eye check-up camp organized by the RCC Lajpore Sachin was a great success. The camp helped in detecting various eye disorders, including cataract, and provided necessary assistance to those who required it. The initiative also helped in spreading awareness about the importance of eye care and regular check-ups. The efforts of the RCC Lajpore Sachin with the support of Ather Foundation and the other participating organizations are highly commendable, and such initiatives should be continued in the future to promote better eye care in rural areas.
