Rtn. Rajesh Desai shared his experience that he has learnt a lot about how the discussion about important club matters carried out in Business Close Meeting.

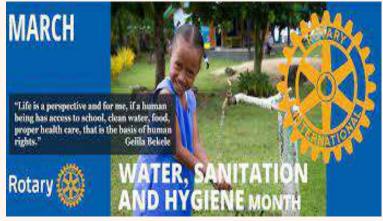
