Project: Recycled Cycles

Rotary club of Surat has initiated the Project 'Recycled Cycles' making a difference in lives of underprivileged children.

It aims to address multiple goals simultaneously. It recognizes the potential of unused resources, the needs of underprivileged individuals, and the importance of environmental sustainability. It also helps in generating source of income for mechanics. The project focuses on collecting donated bicycles, refurbishing them, and distributing them to students in need. Till now 18 cycles have been received and refurbished to put in use. RC Surat incurs a repair cost of Rs. 1000/- per cycle. Still we have more numbers in pipeline for the same.

The project seeks to make use of bicycles that are no longer being used by collecting them from donors. By repurposing these bicycles, their value is maximized, and they are given a new purpose in supporting the transportation needs of underprivileged individuals, specially students.

By encouraging the reuse of bicycles, the project contributes to reducing the environmental impact associated with the production and disposal of new bicycles.

The Recycled Cycles project is an inspiring endeavour that brings together the spirit of giving, resourcefulness, environmental consciousness and create a positive impact in the lives of underprivileged students.


