

#### RI - PRESIDENT JENNIFER E.

A member of the Rotary Club of Windsor-Roseland, Ontario, Canada, Jennifer E. Jones is Rotary International President for 2022-23, making her the **first woman** to hold that office in the organization's 115-year history.

She is the founder and president of Media Street Productions Inc. Jones was chair of the board of governors of the University

of Windsor and of Windsor-Essex Regional Chamber of Commerce. She has been recognized for her service with the YMCA Peace Medallion, the Queen's Diamond Jubilee Medal, and Wayne State University's Peacemaker of the Year Award, a first for a Canadian.

As the first woman president of Rotary, Jennifer Jones wants to follow through on Rotary's Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) Statement and wishes to champion double-digit growth in the number of female members and members under the age of forty, without losing sight of the entire Rotary family. She wants to innovate, educate, and communicate opportunities that reflect today's reality.

The Presidential Rotary Theme for this year is Imagine Rotary. The RI President Jennifer Jones imagines a Rotary where members act to make their dreams become reality and they make the most of their club experience. She urges members to engage more with each other and use these connections to build partnerships that change the world.

A current Rotary Foundation trustee, Jennifer Jones has served Rotary as RI Vice President, Director, Training Leader, Committee Chair, Moderator, and District Governor. She played a lead role in Rotary's rebranding effort by serving as chair of the Strengthening Rotary's Advisory Group. She is the co-chair of the End Polio Now Countdown to History Campaign Committee, which aims to raise \$150 million for polio eradication efforts.

Rtn. Jennifer Jones led the successful #RotaryResponds telethon, which raised critical funds for COVID-19 relief and was viewed by more than 65,000. She has also received Rotary International's Service Above Self Award and The Rotary Foundation Citation for Meritorious Service. She and her husband, Nick Krayacich, are members of The Rotary Foundation's Arch Klumph Society, Paul Harris Society, and the Bequest Society.
