

RAKSHA BANDHAN 11th August 2022, Thursday

Raksha Bandhan literally means "to tie the knot of protection". It has deep religious & cultural significance in India. The sister ties a Rakhi on her brother's wrist & prays for his well-being. The brother offers gifts and promises to always protect her. In the modern interpretation the attention shifts from the religious aspect to a playful exchange of rakhi and gifts. The essence of this festival is to tie the rakhi to someone who has been caring and nurturing towards you. It can be your cousin, friends, parents, pets, etc. The gender and relations take a back seat here.

Fun Facts:

- o In **Rajasthan**, **Lumba Rakhi** is tied on sister-in-law's hand because sisters believe that their brother's wife is the one who takes care of him.
- In Haryana, the state announces free bus rides for women a day before and on the day of the festival so that they can go to their brother's house to celebrate.
- o The religious journey of **Amarnath** ends on the day of Raksha Bandhan.
