Honours and Awards given on Republic Day

- The President's Police Medals: There are 3 medals in this category:
 - (a) for Meritorious Service (b) for Distinguished Service (c) for Gallantry to Law Enforcement Personnel
 - The recipient are granted monthly stipend that is paid to them after retirement and even upon the recipient's death.
- Pradhan Mantri Rashtriya Bal Puruskar: It is given to children under the age of 18 for
 outstanding achievement in innovation, academic achievements, or outstanding service in
 fields such as social services, arts and culture, bravery or sports.
- Padma Awards: There are 3 categories of medals,
 - (a) Padma Vibhushan (b) Padma Bhushan (c) Padma Shri.

They are awarded to citizens of the country for distinguished contribution in fields such as education, arts, literature, science, acting, social service or public affairs. They are amongst the highest civilian awards of the country

- Correctional Service Medal: 3 categories of medals under this are: (a) Distinguished Service,
 (b) Meritorious Service and (c) Gallantry Medals. These medals are awarded to Prison Personnel for their duties in the country's correctional facilities.
- Gallantry Awards: There are 6 awards under this category awarded to Military Personnel of India, (a) Param Vir Chakra (India's Highest Military Award) (b) Mahavir Chakra (Second Highest Military Award) (c) Vir Chakra (Third Highest Military Award) (d) Ashok Chakra (India's Highest Peacetime Military Award) (e) Kirti Chakra (Second Highest Peacetime Gallantry Award) (f) Shaurya Chakra (Third Highest Peacetime Gallantry Award) The last two awards can be given to civilians of the country also.
- The President's Fire Medals: These are awarded to the personnel of the Fire Departments of the country and have 3 categories, (a) Distinguished Service (b) Meritorious Service (c) Gallantry
- **Civil Defense & Home Guard Medals:** Given to personnel from Civil Defense and Home Guards and is divided into 2 categories
 - (a) Distinguished Service (b) Meritorious Service
- Jeevan Raksha Padak: Also divided into the following 3 categories
 - (a) Sarvottam Jeevan Raksha Padak (b) Uttam Jeevan Raksha Padak
 - (c) Jeevan Raksha Padak

These awards are given to civilians for saving someone's life.
