#### Holi in Different States of India

As we all know **Holi**, also known as **Festival of Colours** is celebrated with huge fanfare by the people of India. It is also famous because of the legend of demon **King Hiranyakashyap**, **Prahlad and Holika bonfire**. Holi is not just known by **different names** in **different regions** of India, but it is also celebrated in **different ways** at these places.

Odisha The people of Odisha celebrate "Dola" on the day of Holi where the icons of

Jagannath replace the icons of Krishna and Radha. Dola Melana, processions

of the deities are celebrated in villages and bhoga is offered to the deities.

Holi is known as *Phaguwa* in the local Bhojpuri dialect. On the evening of Phalgun Poornima, people light up the Holika pyre. People play with colors, water, water-balloons and sing folk songs. Delicacies like Dahi Bade, Malpua,

Kachori and 'Bhaang' in thandai or sweets are also consumed.

Gujarat On the evening of first day people lit the bonfire and offer raw coconut and corn to it. The second day is 'Dhuleti' or the festival of color in which people

sprinkle colored water and apply colors to each other.

**Uttar Pradesh (UP)** 'Lath Mar Holi' of Barsana, near Mathura is most popular. Thousands of people

gather in the compound of the Radha Rani Temple to witness this Holi when women beat up men with sticks (lath) as those on the side-lines become hysterical, sing popular Holi Songs and shouts Chants, Sri Radhey or Sri

Krishna.

Bihar

Uttarakhand The Kumaoni Holi here is major musical affair rather than colorful like other

states. People sing songs with a touch of melody, spiritualism and fun. The

songs are based on classical ragas.

Maharashtra The festival is celebrated by burning Holika. The next day people apply color,

gulaal and water on each other and is called 'Rangpachami'. 'Puran Poli' is a

must try here on Holi.

West Bengal Holi is referred as "Dol Purnima", "Dol Jatra" or the "Swing Festival". Idols of

Radha and Krishna on a picturesquely designed palanquin which is taken

round in the streets of the city or the village.

Goa Called Ukkuli in Konkani Holi is celebrated around the Konkani temple called

Gosripuram temple. It is a part of the Goan or Konkani spring festival known as Sigmo, which lasts for about a month. The festivities include: Holika Puja and Dahan, Dhulvad or Dhuli vandan, Haldune or offering yellow and saffron

colour or Gulal to the deity.
