I had been preparing for **JEE 2022** for the last **4 years**. I was in 8th grade when I decided that I want to study **computer science** and that too in one of the best institutes of the country. Leaving The Rajkumar College, Rajkot in class 9th was a big decision which many people criticized.

When preparing for JEE, the most challenging thing is to watch your

friends enjoy themselves at school and miss all the fun. But challenges don't matter when you have a goal and you have the drive to achieve it. There are times when you doubt yourself when the journey is long and the goal is too far. But the only thing which you can do is to work hard and move forward towards your goal. I scored **91.8%** in my class **10**th **boards** which motivated me to perform better and also gave me a lot of confidence.

Things got the hard when COVID hit and my studies shifted to online mode. Out of the 2 most important years of preparation, 18 months were during the COVID period. Studying alone at home without meeting anyone was a big challenge. There were times when there was no motivation to keep studying but as they say, when the going gets tough, the tough gets going.

A week prior to my exam, I was very nervous even though I was well prepared. My parents and teachers played a crucial role in soothing my nerves. All this helped me achieve a **percentile of 99.7** and an **All India Rank** of **2758** in my **JEE examination**, an **All India Rank of 24** in the entrance examination of **IIIT Hyderabad** and **95.2%** in my class **12**th **Boards**. I also cleared my **JEE Advanced examination** with **AIR 3739**.

What I have learnt in these 4 years is that having confidence and believing in yourself is the key to achieve anything you want to. Your focus and your dedication to the commitments you made to yourself decide where you will reach. Even on the days you feel low, you need to work hard with the same energy. And the most importantly never feel your aim is a baggage for you. Instead, learn to enjoy that journey.
