

Trial By Fire is based on the horrific incident of June 1997 Upahar Cinema Case, where a fire broke out in Uphaar Cinema in Delhi, killing 59 innocent people, who were there to watch JP Dutta's Border. Yet there was zero accountability from the culprits of this man-made tragedy, hiding a hushed agreement between the owners and the management.

The seven-part web series now streaming on Netflix, is based on the book of the same name written by the Neelam and Shekhar Krishnamoorthy who are seeking justice for their young children who lost lives in the tragic incident. While struggling to make sense of how both their teenage children perished in the smoke-choked balcony, the doors to which were either blocked or locked, with no emergency lights, no alarm systems, and zero support from the staff who had fled the premises, Neelam and Shekhar Krishnamoorthy set about creating an organisation to help the victims of what came to be known as the Uphaar tragedy.
