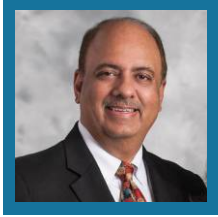

MEMBERS' ACHIEVEMENTS

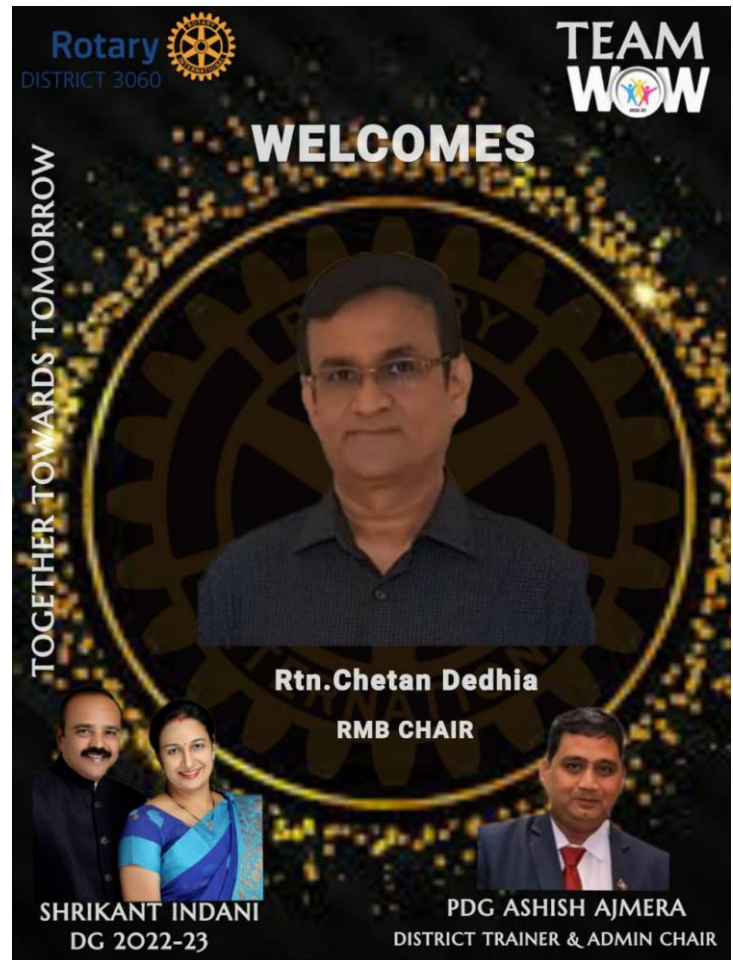

ANNET'S ACHIEVEMENTS



I am Rtr. Achal Shah, son of Rtn. Dr Parag and Rtn Minal Shah. Currently, I am the Talent Advisor and Coach for a Korean-Indian IT Firm called McKinley Rice. In my journey so far, I have seen people disregard one thing in goal setting in life. The mental preparation that goes into it before one chooses a life path. This, in my perception, is the most vital step one needs to take. Let's dive straight to it.

You need to raise your awareness for what you are searching for. Let me explain with a simple example. In order to photograph birds at a lake that I was in, I needed to completely calm myself, listen to the minutest of sounds, be it the rustling of leaves, bird calls in the distance, etc. to even spot a bird.

Now, I would not be just searching for any bird right? If for example, I am searching for owls, I would have done my research, what kind of trees they reside in, what areas have been known to yield the best results, what kind of sounds they make. Now, this sounds simple, I understand that let's correlate it with something we are searching for in our professional life.

Let's say you want to find a job, you need to raise your awareness of all the jobs available which aligns with your interests and skills sets. Now, you need to be aware of what kind of job you are searching for. What industries are open for you? What kind of work culture are you searching for?

Let's take another example, you want to earn money. Well, such an awareness is not enough. How do you want to make money? Do you want to generate a secondary income, or do you just want a better paying job? Do you want to become an entrepreneur?

Asking these questions (the right ones) will heighten your perception and your mind starts to seek answers. This is a magnificent state, keep this running. Don't get stuck to any idea if it does not solve your goal (E.g. making money). At first, one gets more confused, but this is only a temporary phase as your mind is seeking answers in all directions. Multiple pathways lead to confusion, but constantly seeking answers will eliminate one path at a time, and you shall gain clarity.

This was the first phase, with heightened awareness, there is now only one thing left to do now, Take action!

All you need to do is take the leap!
