My Visit to Sevatirth on 8th May 2022, Tarsali Vadodara

Sevatirth, as the name says, is a place to give help to and serve people in need. The motto of Sevatirth is "Who has none, Sevatirth is his or hers". The objective of Sevatirth is to help disabled people stand on their feet and earn their livelihood with dignity. It imparts life skills like tailoring, needle work, embroidery, computer courses to them.

Apart from helping the disabled, it also houses an orphanage, a residency for the blind and for the mentally retarded (women and men) on campus. These orphans are given education so that they can live a good life in society. Training is given to divyangs which will help them to fetch jobs or to do work as self employed.

'Sevatirth" follows the syllabus of Industrial Training Institute ITI which is recognised by the Government of Gujarat. Gujarat Council of Vocational Training (GCVT) Courses are followed in Hand Embroidery, Cutting and Tailoring & Computer Operator and Programming Assistant (COPA).

Sevatirth - there is a great need for such institutions in the society.
