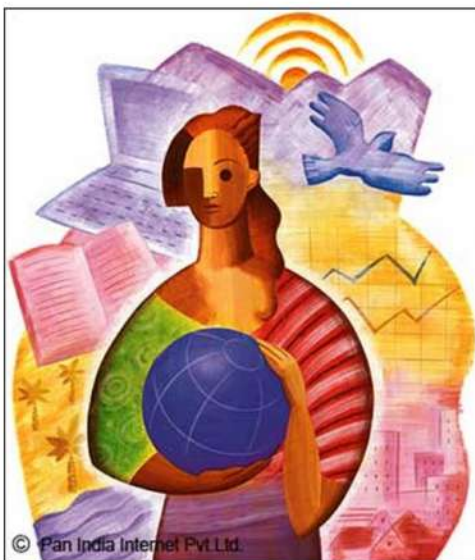

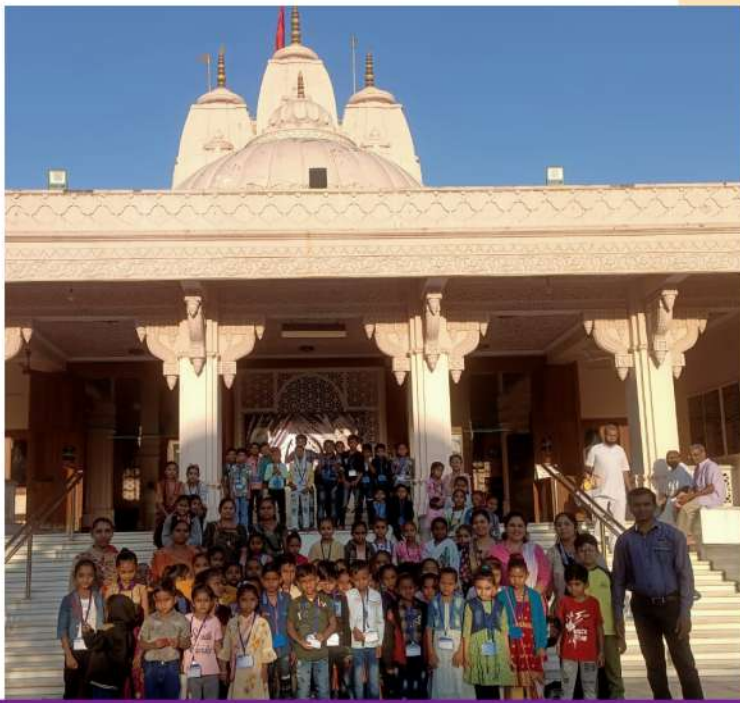

Permanent Project



Physiotherapy Services at Deepak Medical Foundation

RCBS has undertaken a project to extend Physiotherapy Services for Industrial Work force from Rural area arvind Nandesari Industrial Area, in Association with Deepak Medical Foundation. A fully equipped and functional physiotherapy unit was established in December 2021. The growing frequency of trauma cases and accident cases, in the local industries and among the daily commuters in the area, were immensely beneficial due to this support of regular physiotherapy as part of the recovery process. The unit caters to the needs of various other chronic conditions like joint pain, back pain and other orthopaedic diseases. Physiotherapy plays an essential role in addressing lifestyle-related illnesses and ensuring general wellbeing of individuals. Even the senior citizens including geriatric population have been utilising the services.

The objectives of the Physiotherapy unit are to:

- Provide Physiotherapy services to the beneficiaries of Nandesari Industrial Area (NIA)
- Provide ergonomic care and kinesiology for the Industrial Workers
- Provide physical therapy services by screening for and direct treatment of impairments of the movement system that affect participation in daily life roles among local people
- Provide Preventive care for the workers and other occupational health issues



Physiotherapy Services at Deepak Medical Foundation

- Activities Undertaken
 - Extended availability of experienced Physiotherapist at the centre for 4 days a week from twice a week
 - Training and capacity building of nursing assistant to attend to the regular patients as per direction of Physiotherapist
 - Regular community level medical camps to propagate the services and to identify persons needing regular session at the centre
 - Meetings at local industries to popularize the services among the industrial workers
 - Regular follow-up done by the medical team of the patients to ensure continuous treatment is taken by the patients at the centre.
- Outcome Sept 22 - Jan 23
 - Close to 100 visits of patients are recorded for physiotherapy services at the centre. Treatment provided for different types of conditions such as patients with adhesive capsulitis, muscle spasm, lumbar spondylitis with radiculopathy, arm weakness with pain and tingling sensation, knee pain, wrist parentheses, Radial nerve palsy, post-operative physiotherapy, frozen shoulder, post discectomy physiotherapy, plantar fasciitis, dislocated shoulder, post-operative therapy and such other health conditions requiring physiotherapy
 - 3 community based camps were conducted wherein 150 persons were screened and examined by Physiotherapist and recommended therapy as per their conditions.
 - The unit is continuously being popularized in the nearby industrial area and community to increase the utilization.



Official Club Visit

The annual event of Official Club Visit (OCV) by the District Governor, R I D 3060 was scheduled on 07 Feb 2023. Shri. Shrikant Indani, the DG for RY 2023-24 visited our club along with Smt Sarika Indani as scheduled. He was received by the President and the Secretary at around 3.00 pm. He was then led to the workplace of one of our new members, Rtn Nilesh Pandya. The interaction with the member lasted for about 45 minutes, where Shri Nilesh Pandya explained his scope of work and other social activities, while the DG keenly listened to all the details. Thereafter, the DG was invited to visit the Sevasi Prathamik Shala, on the outskirts of Vadodara. Dictionary Distribution was planned during this visit, under the project Gyan-Jyot. There he interacted with the teachers as well as students. He was shown around in the school complex, where RCBS has established certain infrastructure projects like a Hand Wash Station and 32 Ceiling Fans. In addition the club has been conducting regular campaigns in various social awareness aspects like Mom & Me (Menstrual Health & Hygiene), Project Masoom (Good touch / Bad touch), Medical / Dental well-being etc.

The DG was then taken to Hotel Regenta Fairlark, his place of stay. After a short break the OCV resumed, where the DG interacted with the President, President Elect and Secretary for a while before meeting the Board of RCBS. During this meeting the Treasurer and all other chairs briefly spoke about their respective areas. This interaction lasted for about 90 minutes. AG Rtn Manisha Bhatt was present and gave some very constructive inputs.

Official Club Visit

The DG appreciated all the work done by RCBS so far and expressed his satisfaction with the quantum and quality of projects undertaken by RCBS. He further gave his perspective on various aspects of Rotary. He put a lot of stress on younger member profile, The Rotary Foundation (TRF), need for a Permanent Project, Public Image of Rotary etc. He seemed concerned about the frequency of the club meetings and insisted on the club meeting every week. His concern was well received, however, it was discussed that in the present multi-media age, weekly physical meets served little purpose.

After meeting the RCBS Board, the next phase of OCV commenced where the DG interacted with other members of RCBS. The event was innovatively compered by PP Rtn Meeta Shah and Rtn Krupa Mali. A soulful prayer by Ann Bhavna Desai and the Rotary Four-Way Test by Rtn Darshan Vyas set the tone for the evening. The Rotaract and Interact clubs of RCBS presented their respective work done so far, which were appreciated wholeheartedly by the DG. The RCBS progress through the current RY was showcased too. The DG once again appreciated the work done by RCBS in Rotary focus areas and reiterated his views expressed with the Board earlier. He encouraged participation by the younger members and need to contribute towards TRF.

The DG was presented with a copy of the book on Indian Musical Instrument "Sitar", authored by PE Dr Bharat Desai, as token of appreciation.

The OCV concluded with a sumptuous dinner at the Regenta Fairlark.

ચોમાસામાં પાણીની વાત એટલા માટે યાદ રાખવાની છે, આજે પણ દુનિયાની 25% વસ્તી પાસે પાણી માટે કૂવાઓ જ સ્ત્રોત છે, બીજી રીતે કહીએ તો દુનિયાના ઘણા વિસ્તારમાં ભૂગર્ભ પાણી જ એકમાત્ર ઉપાય છે. ધીમે ધીમે ખેતી અને પાણીની જરૂરિયાત 10% ગ્રોથ થી વધશે...હાલ ખેતીમાં 65% ભૂગર્ભ જળ વપરાય છે. ભૂગર્ભ જળનો 11% ઉપયોગ ઇન્ડસ્ટ્રી કરવા લાગી છે.હા, એ પણ તૈયારી રાખજો કે આગામી દાયકાઓમાં જમીનનો દુષ્કાળ આવી રહ્યો છે...

ચોમાસાની વાત એટલા માટે કરવી છે કે વિશ્વમાં લગભગ 30% પાણી ભૂગર્ભ જળ છે, જેના સંગ્રહ માટે વરસાદી પાણી મહત્વનું છે. નદી પર એક હદ કરતાં વધુ ડેમ પાણીનો સંગ્રહ કરી શકે પણ ઇકો સિસ્ટમને ખતમ કરી રહ્યા છે... દરિયા કિનારા તરફની જમીનોમાં ડેમને કારણે ખારાશ વધી રહી છે...

અમદાવાદની પોળોના ઘરો હોય કે સિંધુ સંસ્કૃતિ, ટાંકાઓની પદ્ધતિ હતી... ઇન શોર્ટ, વરસાદી પાણીનો સંગ્રહ થતો હતો.

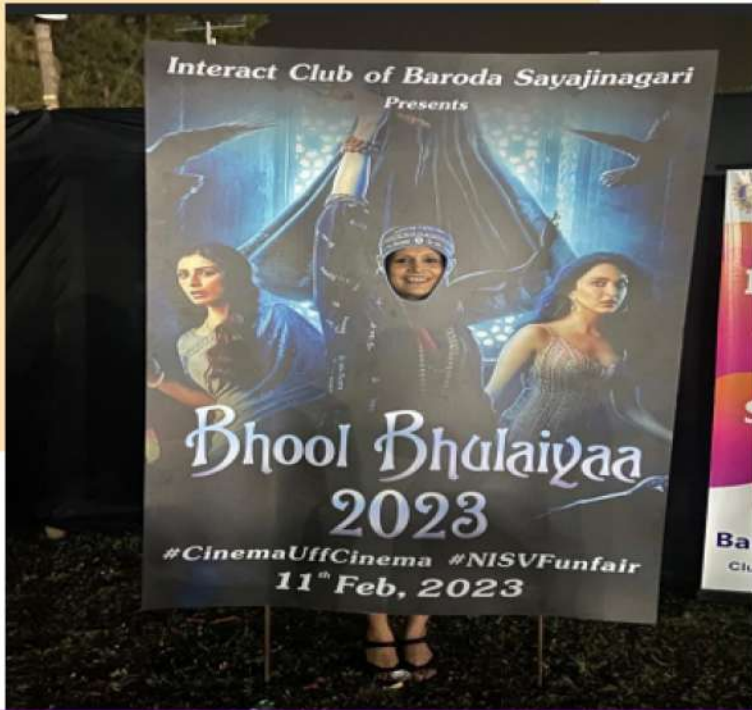

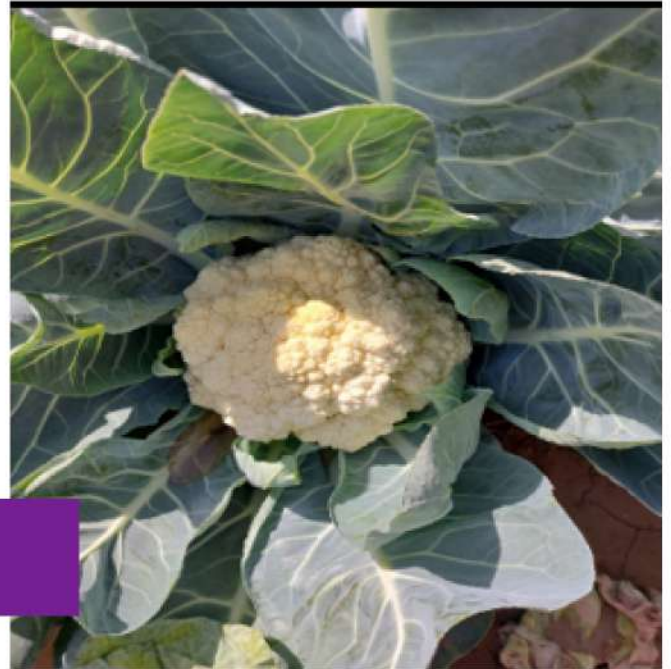




Organic Plantation

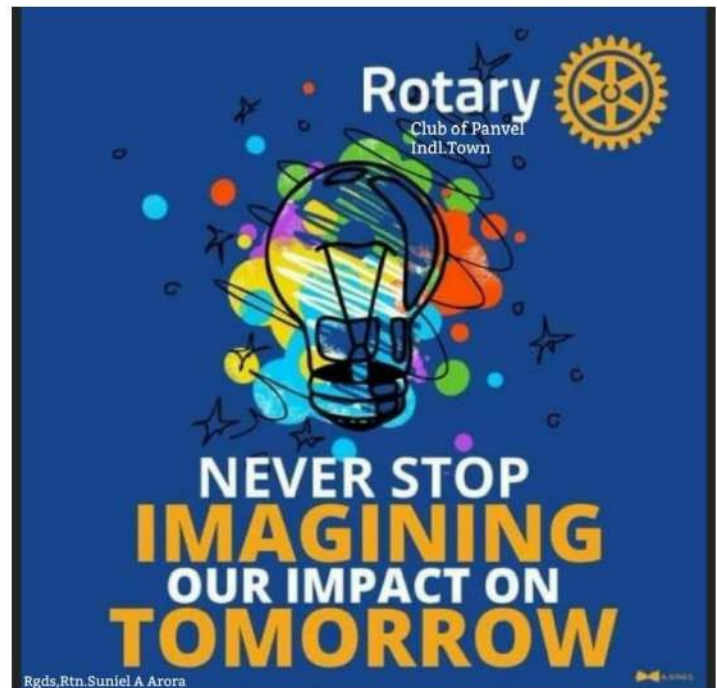
