RI Theme 2022-23



IMAGINE ROTARY

“IMAGINE ROTARY” is the RI theme for the year 2022-23 given by the RI President Jennifer Jones. The theme graphic has been designed by an Australian indigenous artist to link it with the Melbourne Convention in 2023. A circle surrounded by seven dots indicates Rotary with seven focus areas. The colours purple, green and white celebrate diversity, equity and inclusion. Purple is the colour of Rotary’s Polio campaign, Green represents the Environment, White stands for Peace, Empowerment and Newness.

RI President’s theme address:

RI President Jennifer Jones, a member of the Rotary Club of Windsor-Roseland, Ontario, Canada wants members to imagine the possibilities in the change they can make to transform the world. While revealing the RI Theme, she urged people to dream big and harness their connections and the power of Rotary to turn those dreams into reality.



“Imagine, a world that deserves our best,” Jones told incoming district governors on 20 January, “where we get up each day knowing that we can make a difference.”

Engaging members is crucial to retaining members, she said, adding that we need to ask members what they want to get from Rotary and give them meaningful responsibilities. “It is our offer of hands-on service, personal growth, leadership development, and lifelong friendships that creates purpose and passion,” Jones said.



RCBJ is deeply mourned with the passing away of PDG Rtn. Dr. Lal Rathod on Friday, 8th July 2022. He was 87. He had contracted an infection recently which proved fatal.

A member of Rotary Club of Rajkot Mid-Town, PDG Dr. Lal Rathod had served as the District Governor of RI District 3060 in the year 1989-90. He worked for polio-eradication and had served in Africa as medical representative of the United Nations.

A native of Amreli, he had settled in Rajkot. He served as the President of the Saurashtra Cricket Association from 2013 to 2017. He was also the past President of Rajkot Gymkhana Club.

PDG Dr. Lal Rathod was a noble human being, philanthropist and a remarkable doctor. His contributions to the Rotary and to the world of medicine and cricket will be remembered forever.

He is survived by his son Sunil Rathod (based at UK), daughter Dr. Lisa Tank (based in USA) and grandchildren.
