



HISTORY OF ROTARY CLUB OF TRIVANDRUM CENTRAL


Rotary Club of Trivandrum Central, One of the earliest club of Trivandrum District, was sponsored by R.C. Trivandrum South.. The idea of forming this club was mooted in April 1985. A few Rotarian Rtn.Adv.N.Krishnankutty, Rtn.P.Gopinath, Rtn.R.S.Nair, Rtn.P.A.Varma, Rtn.N.G.Pillai, Rtn.Charley John of Rotary Club of Trivandrum South, with our member Rtn.K.Janardanan Nair, invited a group of likeminded people, mainly friends to form the Rotary Club of Trivandrum Central.The organisation meeting was held on 14.03.1986 at which the club was named as Rotary Club of Trivanrum Central. The Constitution and Byelaw was adopted , and the new Office bearers were elected..Thus the provisional club of Trivandrum central came into existence.The first nuclear meeting of the provisional club was held at hotel JAZ International, on 21st May 1986, and subsequently the weekly meetings of teh club are being held at Hotel Amrithe, Thycaud, on every Friday at 7 pm.Then the application was accepted by RI and the CHARTER was issued on June 1986 itself.
