

Rotary Club Jaipur Roundtown was Chartered on 26 January 1990 as fifth Club of Jaipur. RI president-elect Rajendra K Saboo and District Governor Justice S.N. Bhargava presented the Charter to GSR,PDG Rtn. Dr Ashok Gupta.

The city of Jaipur, popularly known as Pink City is a major tourist destination and is a capital city of the largest state of the country- Rajasthan. Pink city Jaipur is famous for installing free prosthetic Limbs “Jaipur foot”, Historical Forts and palaces, world fame structure airy Hawamahal, temples, Gold and Silver jewellery, Blue pottery, Block printing and Vegetable organic dyed cotton fabric, Mojari shoes, Bangles and of course tasty Rajasthani food.

The club has the unique distinction of sponsoring the first-ever TRF 3H grant and district 3050 amounting to US dollar 1,70,000. The mission was providing drinking water in the rural areas of Dudu situated 60 km from Jaipur. Four check dam, 15 overhead tanks were constructed and 35 kms of pipeline was laid down covering over 15 villages where drinking water was made available.

Rotary Club Jaipur Roundtown has hosted 4 district conferences and three district assemblies and has sponsored five new Rotary Clubs.

Rotary Club Jaipur Roundtown also has a privilege of providing Frontline leadership to the district with Three PDG's PDG Rtn. Dr. Ashok Gupta (Governed 1997-98), PDG Rtn AJay Kala (Governor 2002-03) and PG Rtn Ramesh Agrawal (Governed 2014-15)

Our PDG Rtn Dr. Ashok Gupta had the privilege to share the Jaipur Rotary Institute organised by our district 3054 (ertwhile district 3052) in December 2015 at Jaipur.

The per capita contribution to rotary Foundation is US dollar 1350/- which is the highest in the district apart from the PHF's and Major donors. Our club has a unique privilege of having Two “Arch Klumph Society” (AKS) fellow. They are our PDG Rtn Dr Ashok Gupta and are PDG Rtn Ramesh Agrawal both having individually contributed US dollar 2,50,000 each to the TRF.

Rotary Club Jaipur round town also has TRF endowment fund. PDG Rtn Dr Ashok Gupta has generously contributed Rd. 11 lakh for building a “Check Dam” known as “Kalyan Dam” in honour of our RI President Kalyan Banerjee of India. Various projects undertaken by us in past 7 years are :

Construction of Toilets for girls in Govt School, Class rooms for schools, Providing Basic Furniture to school, Providing Dust bins under Happy school project and swacchha Bharat Mission

Annapurna Prasadi (Free meal) project for 15 thousand patients and attendants at SMS Hospital, Jaipur,

Our matching grant project number 1876955 is to provide equipment by February 2020 for treatment of eyes at Calgary Eye Hospital with budget of USD 85000, with Rotary Club Rajdhani Nepal district 3292 International partner.

Our club under Global grant number GG-1529280 installed a laboratory, Diagnostics and training centre of Swasthya Kalyan Kendra at Jaipur with the total budget of USD 55000 benefiting one lakh economically weak people.

Our club under Global grants number GG 2012117 have installed a 70 bedded Covid ward in the Rajasthan Hospital Jaipur with international partner RC Emorydruidhills USA district 6900 and with total budget of USD 6900 during pandemic in 2020.

Presently we have initiated a project GG 2127249 with estimated cost of USD 87000 to install Oxygen plant and an Ayurved center at Jaipur.

We have sponsored Two Rotract Clubs as Maheshwari Girls college and Jaipur Roundtown

We have sponsored one Interact club also installed this year
