#### JEEVANDHARA BLOOD DONATION CAMP

A blood donation camp was organized on 1st July 2025 at Mulund West Railway Station platform from 9am to 5.30pm. This was in association with **Grant Medical College and J. J. Group of Hospitals Blood Centre**. Apart from our club, all Rotary Clubs, Inner Wheel clubs and Rotaract clubs of Mulund, participated in the camp. The donors were provided with a certificate from the Blood Centre and also a Umbrella was given as token gift.



From our club President Seema Kshirsagar, Secretary Vaishali Nair, PP Natarajan T. R., IPP Asha Narang, Rtn. Ajit Sankaran, PP Rajiv Shah and PP Narayana Shagrithaya attended the camp. Rtn. Ajit Sankaran and PP T. R. Natarajan donated blood. President Seema, Secretary Vaishali and IPP Asha Narang also vounteered to donate blood, but could not do due to technical reasons. Blood donations were conducted at various Railway stations throughout the District. We could collect 76 bottles of blood at Mulund center.

# CATARACT FREE BHANDUP CAMP

As a part of our ambitious project "Cataract Free Bhandup", cataract screening and eye check up camps are organised on the first Saturday of every month. It is going on from August 2022 regularly. Presently it is being organised at Datta Mandir, Near Hotel Gopalashram, Near Mulund Checknaka, Thane. So far we have screened more than 2600 persons and carried out more than 1100 cataract surgeries. This is in association with Bhaktivedanta Hospital and Research Institute, Mira Road - with kind help from Wagle Estate Lorry Owners' Association and Hotel Gopal Ashram.



In the cataract screening and surgery camp held on 5<sup>th</sup> **July 2025**, 88 beneficiaries were screened and out of them 50 were detected for cataract.

Out of the 50, 40 were sent to Bhaktivedanta Hospital at Mira Road on 6<sup>th</sup> July 2025 & 10 were sent on 8<sup>th</sup> July and surgery was successfully carried out. Also 23 persons were provided with spectacles free of cost.



**Dr. Niteesha Agarwala** of Hinduja Hospital and a member of Rotary Club of Bombay visted our camp today. She took a quick round our screeing camp and ambulance. She was highly appreciative of the excellent work we are doing in association with Bhakti Vedanta Hospital.
