Minutes of the RWM No 3619 dt.10-08-2022 held at RC Hall at 7 p.m.

President Rtn. Rabindra Nath Datta was on chair. At the beginning he welcomed all the Rotarians present. On his request Rtn. Gopa gayen led the National Anthem. President elaborately discussed about the Mega Vaccination programme, Booster Dose, organised by our club on Saturday August $6^{\rm th}$, 2022 from 11=00 a.m. to 5=00 p.m. along with Howrah Municipal Corporation in collaboration with Government of West Bengal (Department of Health & Family Welfare). Rtn. Dr. Monosij Dhara. Co-ordinated the programme. Near about 200 persons were vaccinated out of which forty persons were administered Covaxin.

President declared that On August $15^{\rm th}$, 2022, $75^{\rm th}$ Independent day Flag Hosting will be held at the roof top of Rotary Community Hall sharp at 10=00 a.m., All interested members should assemble at RC Hall at 9=30 a.m. Thereafter at 11=00 a.m. President Elect Rtn. Dr. Debasis Sanyal will lead the members to Howrah General Hospital for distribution of food articles to paediatric dept. Total sixty numbers of dry packed food will be distributed to the child patient at Howrah hospital where flag hoisting will be held at 11 a.m. by the Superintendent of the hospital in presence of us. PP Rtn. Santanu Banerjee will donate the food packets and Rtn. Anima Datta donate the printed bag for carrying those food packets.

PP Rtn. Prajapati Mondal, Chairman, R. C. C. announced that on August 28th, 2022 he along with club members will visit R. C. C. Netaji Sangha and hand over approximately fifty number of Sarrees and some dry food packet, thereafter if possible to R. C. C. Kalagachia Santi Sanghs, Hauli Bagan to hand over thirty numbers of sarees and thirty numbers of School Bags. For going to those places, He suggested to assemble at Kriya Path lab at 9=00 a.m. Rtn. Mondal further informed that before Durga Puja he want to visit R. C. C. Chironabin and distribute ladies garments and dry food packets. Date & time will be informed in the next RWM to be held during first week of September 22.






4) Report on celebration of 75th Independence Day:-
