1. Rtn. Vijayaraman from Chennai, India started clapping for raising funds for Polio Plus program, that made history as the longest continuous clapping. It was 58 hours and 9 minutes.

Rtn. Nagaraj Shetty presented the Treasurer's Report.

The meeting was concluded with announcements and Vote of Thanks by Secretary Rtn. Farida Uppin, National Anthem and Group Photo.

2. Rotary is credited with a world record for World's Biggest Commercial, Rotary's public awareness campaign for polio eradication, the photo awareness campaign of Rotary, in which more than one lakh people from as many as 171 countries uploaded their photos.

3. In Feb 2002, National Polio Plus committee of India displayed a cloth banner measuring 50.4 kilometres long in Mumbai. PDG Deepak Kapoor, Chairman of India's National Polio Plus Committee received the Guinness Record for the Longest Banner.

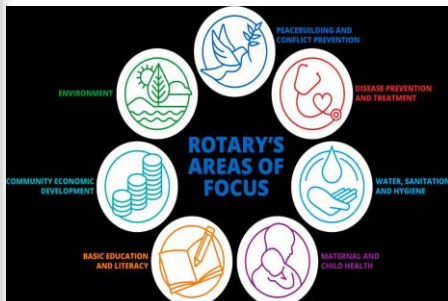
