

Dr. Kamath's effort in labour management for the pond restoration projects were substantial. He personally funded around Rs. 1.5 lakh per pond for the labour wages, excavators for the execution of work. The project demanded meticulous planning and significant effort, which resulted in an increased water table through cleaning & desilting. Additionally, Dr. Kamath raised awareness among the local residents about the importance of water conservation, inspiring many people in the process.



Dr. Satish Kamath was honored with the People of Action Award and presented with a plaque for his significant contributions to society. His inspiring story showcases how his passion for giving back led to widespread involvement and successful project execution. This reflects the same transformative impact that Rotary projects often have, bringing people together to achieve meaningful outcomes.
