Mr. K Shivaram Manja shared his experience in Defence. He said that Independence is achieved by the sacrifices of freedom fighters and it is now our responsibility to keep it. He said that he learnt discipline, loyalty and perseverance in army. He worked with people of different culture & faith and learnt to be respectful to diversity.

Varsha Shirali shared her experience as Fauji Wife. She sacrificed her IT profession, overcame the language barrier and adapted herself to the new life as a teacher and trainer to the wives and children of soldiers. She used to visit their houses and resolve the HR issues of the army official's family, took care and taught their children. She won the confidence and love of their family members and comforted them in challenging situations. She had to shift from house to house and her child had to change schools several times depending on the deputation location of her husband.
