What a motivating and insightful RBSW's third weekly meeting held on July 28th. Amidst this pandemic time technology has taken over the world...our lives too! In all this RBSW's new website has been launched virtually. Prepared by the efforts of the Club Secretary Karthik Kittu and a few rotroactors new website of Rotary Bangalore Southwest RBSW.ORG was unveiled during the session. In the virtual meet, the special guest was the senior Rotarian A.S. Venkatesh, RI Director (2020-21) who pumped up the fellow Rotarians with his stimulating inspiring speech on the vital subject of "The future of Rotary". While interacting with the fellow Rotarians, Rtn. Venkatesh admired and emphasized that apart from the motives of friendship and service now Rotary is considering as a venue of a network for business purposes too. Rtn. Venkatesh further mused, "With the advancement and the technological revolution, we also need to change our approach and should try to stay relevant. Clubs need to do appropriate amendments with time." Giving an example of club attendance, he said that after 2016 every club is free to choose 100% members' attendance requirements. Now rather than stressing on members' attendance, clubs can opt for members' involvement and engagement in club services. Similarly, through hybrid meetings clubs can maintain good members' strength in their weekly meetings. In a hybrid meeting, members are free to join the meet virtually and can also present physically at the venue. By citing examples of two U.S. states, viz., Georgia and Ohio he said that club members through hybrid meetings are maintaining 95% attendance there. On a positive note, Rtn. Venkatesh said, "It is a good sign that because of advanced technology membership of young Rotroactors and especially

women brigade are increasing in every Rotary club. In this vein, I am glad to share that in the next RI Board amongst 17 members 8 are women Rotarians." In the end, he mentioned that Google in today's time is considered as a knowledge bank and has changed the entire scenario. Everyone is dependent on technology now. He further said, "In the near future I strongly feel that Rotary clubs as a necessity will work with corporate and government bodies."

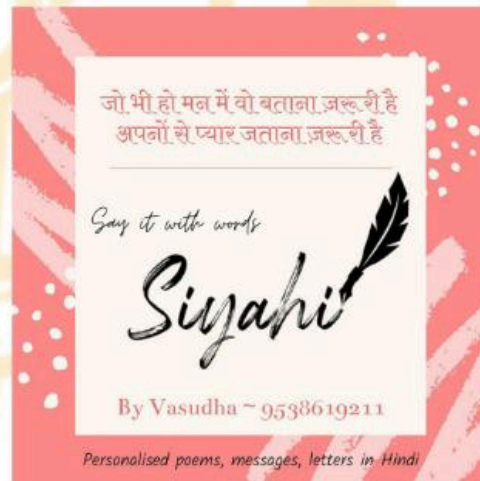

Background of Julapalya High School

Every year RBSW conducts programmes at Julapalya High School in Baggepalli Taluk, Chikkaballapur District. The school has classes for 8th, 9th and 10th standard students, all from weaker sections and backward area.

RBSW started projects at Julapalya nearly a decade back and more effectively from FY 2010-11 when Rtn Bhagwan was the President. District Governor Rtn Mananath Sarath also visited during the same year. Following year, DG late Parshanna Potnis also visited.

Year after year, every President of RBSW continued the projects at Julapalya. Though it happens to be the birth place of Rtn B.N. Krishnamurthy, it is the highest impression and confidence gained by the Club due to the absolute dedication of the teachers and the students with sincerity and humility writ on their faces, sustaining the interest of RBSW. Responsibility for implementation of projects and prompt feedbacks from the school management, are added anchors.

The peak was when Rtn Late Murali Dutt was President. A regular water filtration plant was set up, which was the first in the RI District as well as in any school in Chikkaballapur District. RBSW has set up a science Lab and a Library. Huge health camps have been conducted not only for the school but villages around the School. E-Learning kits, sports goods and uniforms, computers and several others, to enhance the school environment, improve health of students and quality of teaching, have been provided by RBSW. In so much so, school came to being recognized as 'Adopted School of RBSW'.

The news of RBSW work at Julapalya spread around the area and an request, Club also has conducted programmes at Chelur, Baggepalli, Hilar, Pathapalya, in the same District.
