Twenty-five of our members graciously volunteered for this heartwarming event.

Our Club Services were further enriched by the insights of two distinguished speakers. CA Rajendra Kumar, a veritable encyclopedia on GST and taxation, shared his extensive knowledge, while IG Sudhakar, Additional Commissioner of Police (Traffic) for Greater Chennai, outlined his vision for achieving an accident-free Chennai with zero fatalities and smoother traffic flow.

In Community Services, we proudly relaunched the Kamaladevi Srisrimal Girl Child Education Project, benefiting 465 girls and providing financial aid to 5 teachers. Additionally, we celebrated Independence Day at Chennai High School, Kannamapet, by distributing notebooks, water bottles, and furniture to the students.

Our Community Health initiatives achieved significant milestones, including reconstructive hand surgeries for 40 leprosy patients and a large-scale Eye Donation Awareness Rally in collaboration with RECH. We also organized a Mega Blood Donation Camp in partnership with the Interact Club of PSSB Millennium School, OMR.

All avenues of service were in full swing throughout the month, with over **14** Annadanams and **8** eye camps successfully conducted. We also launched a new initiative, "Madras Speaks English, " distributing **3,000 textbooks to students in grades 4** through 8 across five corporation schools.





The project cost is Rs.2,50,000. This was possible by the benevolent members of RCMT and Chairman of Medisales Group Rtn. Narendra Srisrimal.












