As we bid farewell to the past year and welcome the new year, I wish to express my heartfelt gratitude to each one of you, for your commitment to our club's mission and values. Truly inspiring!

My main motto as President for the year 2024-2025 with theme the Magic of Rotary, is to find a balance between continuity and change and work towards creating a positive impact in every single project we do for the year.

For the past six months our mobile medical van has been able to treat more than 2500 patients covering many parts of the city, 62 babies have been operated in Balnethra project so far. Akshayam, our weekly distribution of food packets at Adyar Cancer Institute has been very satisfying - more than 1000 people have been given lunch packets. The heavy downpour in the month of December did not dampen the RCCT spirit of service.

Wishing Well project at Zia orphanage for our members and the distribution of toys to children at Mahesh Memorial Paediatric oncology centre, as part of Christmas celebrations, have been very exciting for the beneficiaries and our members.

Voice of District - Season 16, our signature event, was successfully completed with new categories included. The participation of our Rotractors added to the fun.

Trip to Aavin Milk factory and Digital Training of women entrepreneurs of TN Rise women start up council, as part of Vocational service Avenue have been very successful and we are planning the next session to train more women.

Diverse perspectives, from different backgrounds broaden our members' understanding of the challenges in the complex global world of today - be it Cyber security issues or Investments in the future, our speaker meetings organized by the Club Service team, have been very informative and interesting. Similarly, our Fellowships with Onam and Diwali themes promoted a vibrant, culturally rich and festive atmosphere. Not to forget the main attraction - Sabha Sapad at Music Academy.

The village trip to Villupuram, despite Cyclone Fengal, turned out to be the most challenging, yet most memorable experience for everyone.

Our Rotractors winning awards at the District Rotract Council for doing community service projects brings in joy and I appreciate the dedication of these youngsters.

For the next six months, we have lined up interesting projects like Donation of portable toilets to the Army, target of operating 250 babies under Balnethra project, Fundraising for SCOLIOSIS (medical condition characterized by an abnormal curvature of the spine) focused on diagnosis and treatment especially for children and adolescents. And of course, our much-awaited Club trip to Bali.

The Governor Visit is scheduled for March 18th and the Vocational Awards ceremony is being planned in true RCCT style. The mobile medical van will continue its service treating patients.

I strongly believe in Membership Development - bringing in more people towards service and creating more leadership opportunities for members. Hence I request all of you to work towards inducting like-minded new members for our club.





On learning that he would be visiting our city, many industrialists, top business men and members of the press tried to contact him and get his appointment for an interview but he declined saying his itinerary would only be decided by the host.

After appearing at a Press Conference, he graced the Rotary Meeting and ceremony at Ambassador Pallava, gave a very moving speech with humility and nobility. His simplicity stood out throughout this visit, as he dined together with the members of the Club. He even denied special taxis/limousines to ride in my car. After reaching New Delhi, he sent a beautiful "Thank you" note in his own handwriting, which I cherished for a long time. It was one of the most memorable days of my life!


