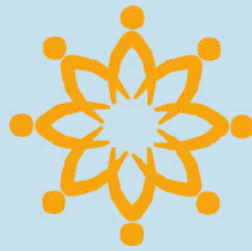

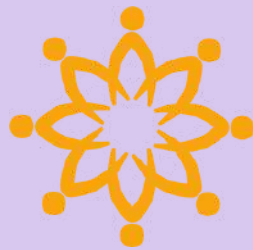

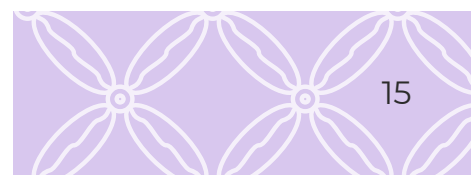

# Diwali celebrations at Sevasadan

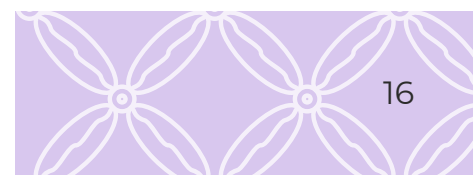


## Skill Development Workshop
