The Street Food of Madras!

The Fellowship Culinary Art Loving Rotarians (FOCA) had organised this very first trip and I also joined them to explore the street food of Madras aka Chennai. Kai yendhi Bhavan,vandi kadai, gaadi dhaba, all of them are unique! They sell street food! In Mumbai there are Kau Gallies only with street food vendors and no other shops and no vehicles are allowed inside, one can only walk through like the Walking Street of Pattaya.

These cart owners are people who do not have the wherewithal to invest and run a full fledged hotel but are specialists in their own little way. They make the delicacies instantly, sell and make their collection for the day and one can be assured it's genuinely fresh since none of them have refrigerators to store.

We started off with Ankur Malaai at the Agarwal Bhavan on a sweet note, and proceeded to Shiv Shakthi chat bhandar, the bread bajji wala who is located at the inter junction of Govindappa Naicken street and Narayana Mudali lane, fresh bread bajjis and kachoris with masala inside were gobbled up, with the tingling mirchi taste asking for more!

Then we entered into Mint street, only to find ourselves at Anmol Lassiwala, who serves fresh thick lassi with kesar badam mix, a real treat to the young .he serves it in a 400 ml lotta and one allowed consume more than half!

The next of course was the Kakada Ramaprasad joint, where we tasted the fresh hot Jilebis, Pani puri, Bhel puri and we moved to the next spot, Chinnappan Murukku sandwich, located at the inter junction of Devaraja Mudali street and NSC Bose road. The Murukku is just about 30 mm dia, with one at the top and one at the bottom with a slice of cucumber, tomato, cheese, onion and some masala carefully stuffed with a topping of sauce that was optional. It was so yummy and after emptying half a dozen water bottles, we moved to the very next shop where fresh karumbu juice of our choice was available. The next sojourn was Mehta bros at Mint street, about 15 buildings away from Chinnamma Kovil where we to had a taste of fresh vada paav, the highlight here was of course the fried fresh green chilli that was as accompaniment to it which was an inviting add on!

The last leg of the evening saw us move on to Cheena Bhai (Actually the owner is Srinivasan, aka Cheena) hotel located opposite Krishnaprasad only to taste the fresh dosas and Oothappams of all varieties made to our specs and after finishing all of that, to quench the thirst and for a feel good factor, we moved to the very next shop where there was excellent elaneer payasam. This was the last leg of the trip!

With our stomach and hearts full, we took pictures and we all disbursed and I felt I needed to walk atleast a few kilometres to make good the extra calories! This was truly a visual, olfactory and a gustatory experience that will stay in my mind and memory forever!
