Marking the commencement of two WASH projects initiated by the Rotary Club of Madras, Bhoomi Pooja ceremonies were held on May 14th at two historic Chennai schools.











Presidency Girls Higher Secondary School, Egmore

Established in 1783, the Presidency Girls Higher Secondary School in Egmore is one of Chennai's oldest educational institutions. It is renowned for its commitment to empowering young women through quality education. Over the years, the school has witnessed various transformations, including a notable facelift recently to serve as a model institution. RCM's project at this school includes renovations and infrastructure upgrades, such as the installation of paver blocks and the refurbishment of toilet facilities.









Chintadripet Higher Secondary School

Following the ceremony at Egmore, Rotarians proceeded to the Chintadripet Higher Secondary School, an institution with a rich heritage dating back to 1845. Located in one of Chennai's oldest planned neighborhoods, Chintadripet has a storied history as a weavers' settlement established in the 18th century. At this school, the WASH project involves the construction of a new toilet block equipped with modern facilities, addressing sanitary longstanding infrastructural needs and promoting better hygiene practices among students.




