In an interaction program with victims of current issues in Manipur, a family from Moreh shared a harrowing incident that had occurred.



During the discussion, District Governor Sukhminder emphasized that we should not impose administrator/admission fees on new members and suggested changing the term to club development fees in the bylaws. He also stressed the importance of including a note in any bylaws amendment specifying the date and meeting number when the resolution for the amendment was adopted. Additionally, he recommended changing the term "outstation members" to "non-residential members." Furthermore, he requested our club to send all copies to a specific address when writing to the Rotary news. He advised scheduling board meetings on the 3rd Saturday of every month, with the flexibility to amend the schedule as needed. The District Governor urged us to organize at least 6 club assemblies and 4 board meetings annually and to aim to increase our membership by at least 3 or 4 members each year.
