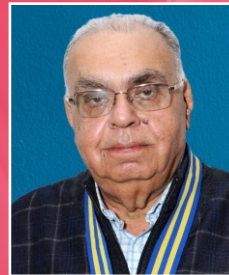

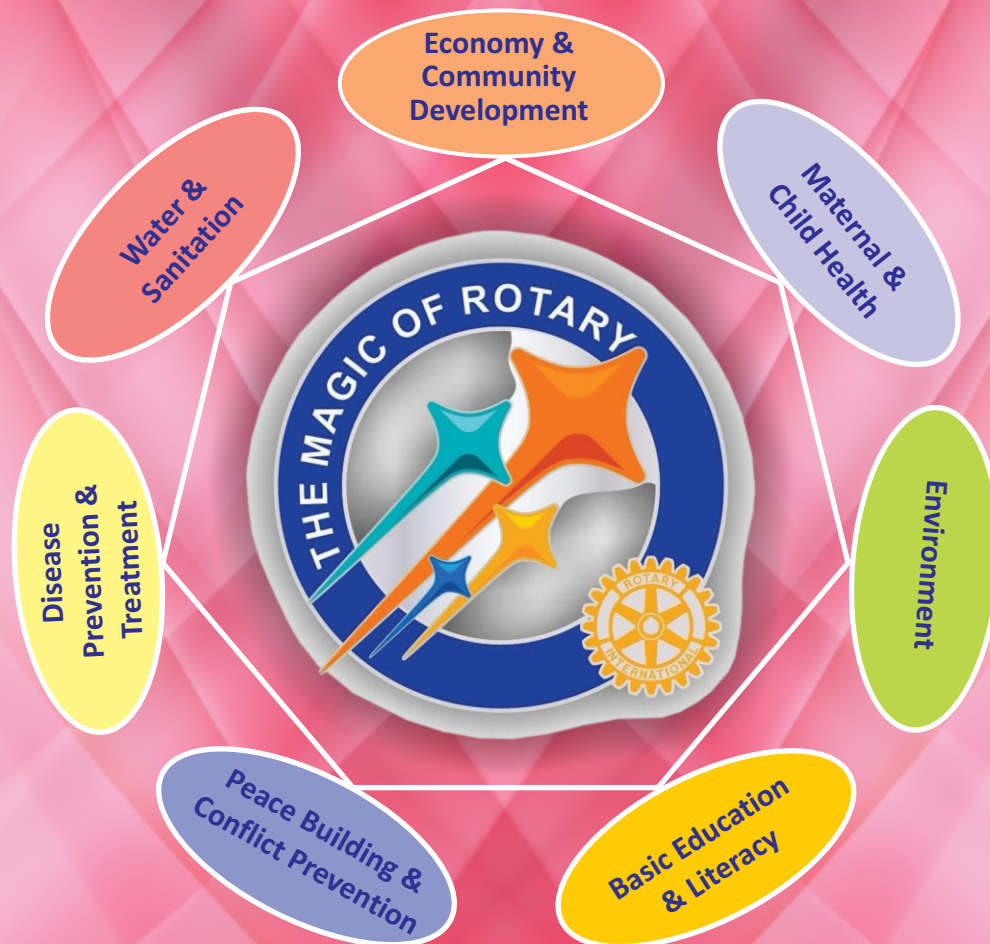

The meal was sponsored by Rtn Dr. Arun Raisurana and Rsp Meenu Raisurana.

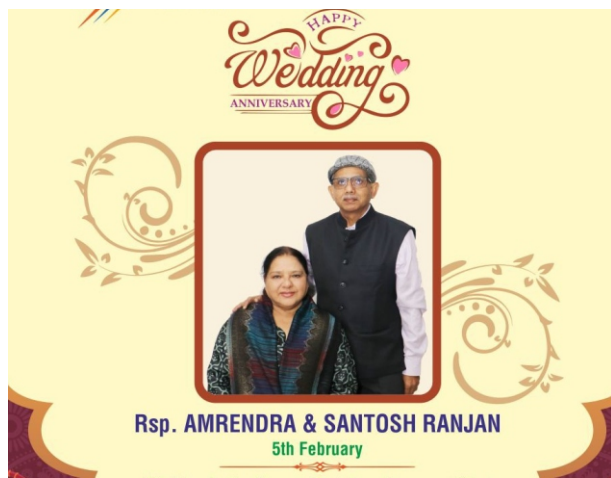
