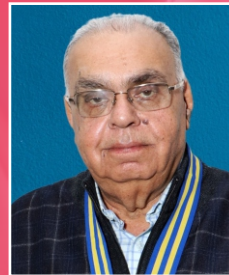

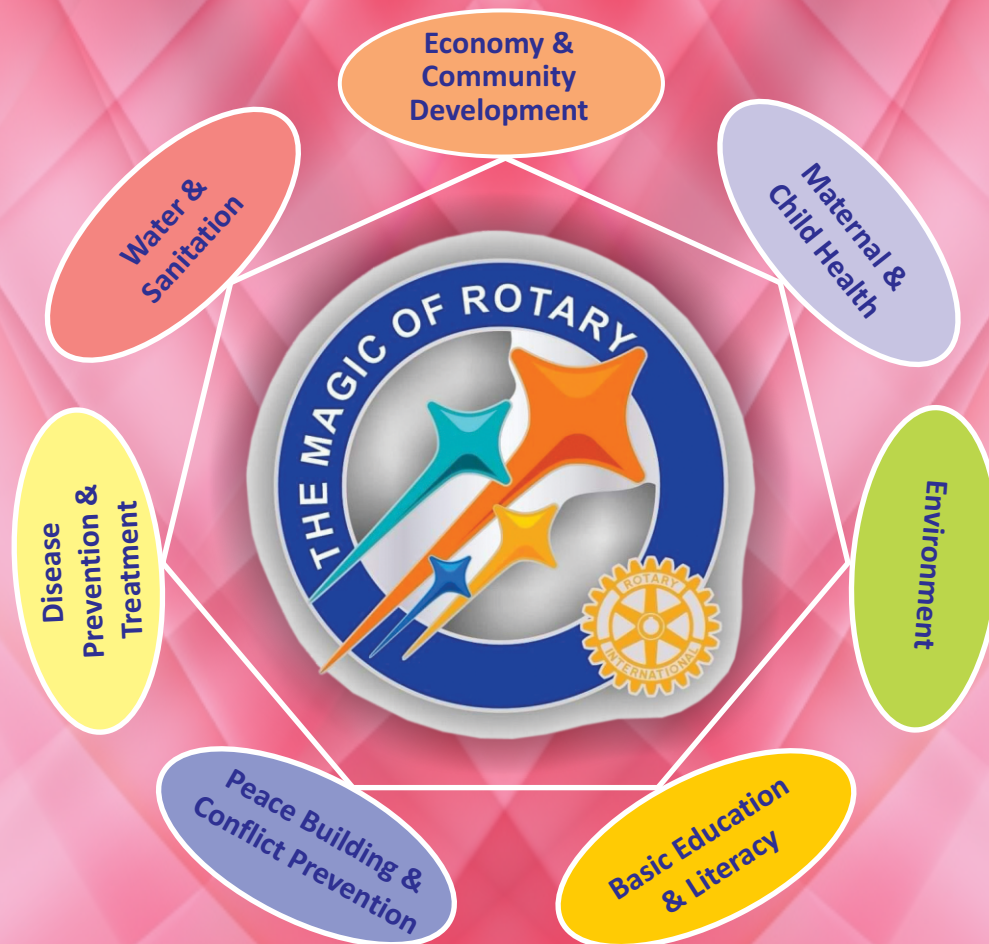

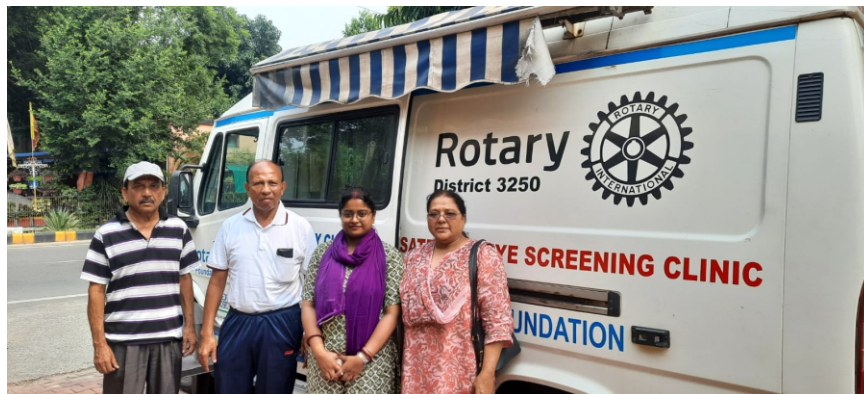

## FROM SATELLITE CLUB OF BIRDERS

In continuation of the efforts to engage Eco Club students of schools on Ecological Conservation, the Rotary Satellite Club of Jamshedpur initiated a pilot project on Biodiversity Mapping of school campuses.
