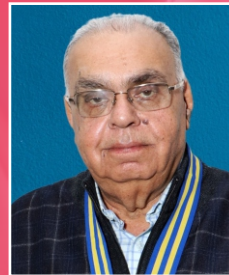

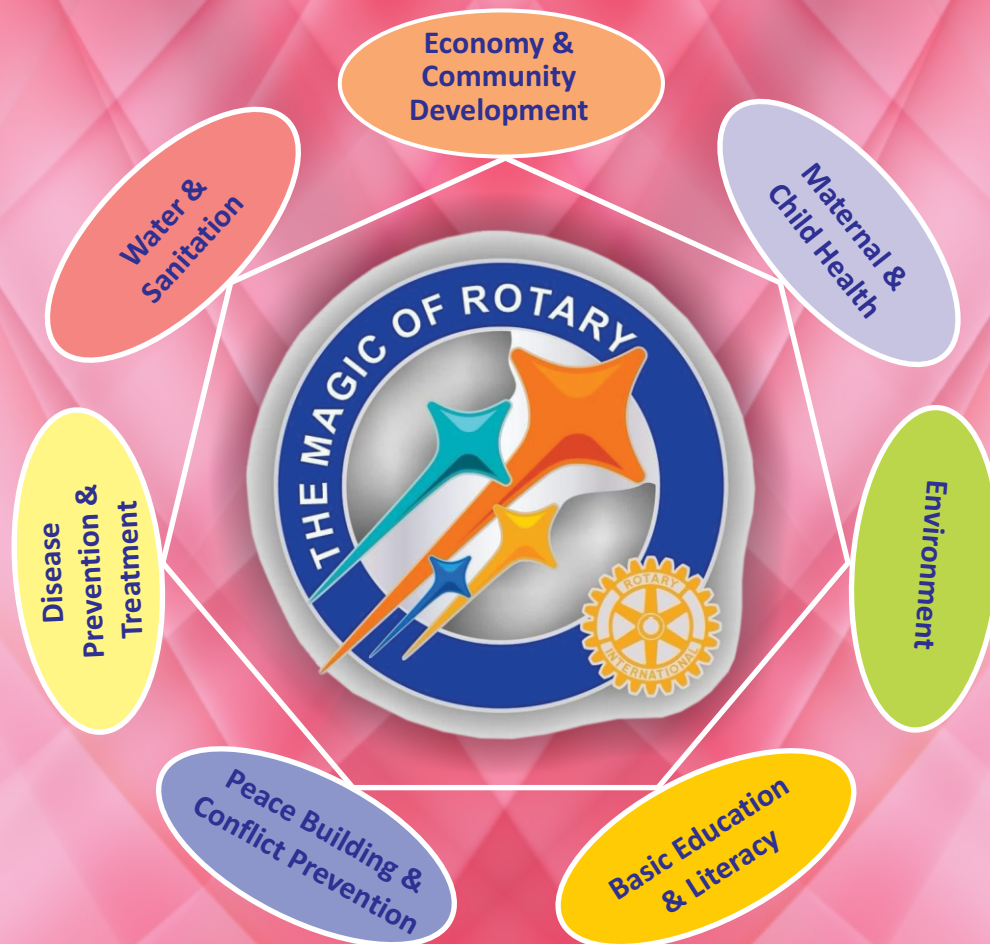

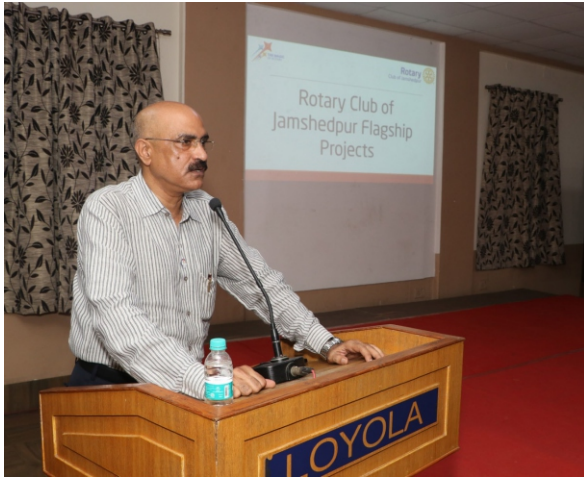


INTERACT CLUB OFFICE BEARERS INSTALLATION CEREMONY
