

Many founded vital organizations or hold leadership roles in governments, nongovernmental organizations, and international institutions like the United Nations and World Bank.

One inspiring story is that of Ntang Julius Meleng, a 2024 Rotary Peace Fellow at Makerere University in Uganda. Through his Social Change Initiative, Julius has worked to empower young people in Cameroon to take active roles in peacebuilding and leadership.

His project provided training in conflict prevention, civic engagement, and leadership to youths and community officials in areas affected by conflict, equipping people to drive sustainable peace efforts. Julius harnessed Rotary's global network to overcome obstacles, including limited funding and security risks, and make a meaningful impact.

The Rotary Peace Fellowship gave Julius the tools and support to turn his vision into reality. His work embodies The Magic of Rotary — the transformative power of connecting people, sharing resources, and uniting for a common purpose.

This event is a fundraiser trying to support the treatment of Cancer patients. Participants can register with a fee of INR 500, which includes a complimentary T-shirt, medal, and certificate. Every registration is a vital contribution to supporting cancer patients in their treatment journey. During this event, Rotary club of Jamshedpur Steel City is also honouring the 4 champions of our city who have successfully completed the Ironman 70.3 Goa 2024 and made Jamshedpur proud.

Dr Neelam Jain, Siddharth Adeshra, Prateek Kauntia and Arjun Murarka started training for the competition with Arise Performance. Their grit, discipline and determination was what led them over the finish line in Goa on 27th October 2024. Ironman 70.3 is a trademark. It stands for the total distance covered in miles during the event. It comprises a 1.2mile (1.9km) swim, 56mile (90km) bike and 13.1mile (21.1km) run. Exactly half the length of an Ironman.
