Thanks to your support and encouragement, we have successfully completed our second month of Service and fellowship for the Rotary year 2024-25.



The Magic of Rotary: A Story of Support and Gratitude.

On June 2nd, 1991, our son Gaurav, who was less than a year old at the time, was running a high fever of 101°F. My wife, Deepika, was preparing to board the Purushottam Express from New Delhi railway station with our son and daughter. Concerned about Gaurav's health, she called me for advice. After some discussion, we decided it was best for them to continue the journey.

By the time the train reached Banaras at 7 a.m., Gaurav's fever had risen to 102.5°F. I grew increasingly anxious, unsure of how to get the medical help my son needed. At that moment, I noticed the Rotary District directory beside me. I quickly looked up the contact information for the President of the Rotary Club of Sasaram in Bihar and reached out for assistance.



When the train arrived at Sasaram station at 11 a.m., I was relieved to see Rtn. Prasad, the club's president, waiting there with the club secretary and two doctors. They came prepared with medicines and even brought a basket of fruits. The doctors examined Gaurav and administered the necessary treatment, bringing us immense relief.

I will never forget the comfort and support we received that day. I am forever grateful to my Rotary family, who stepped in when we needed them the most. Rotary's global network of over 1.2 million members across more than 36,000 clubs truly feels like family, always ready to lend a hand for any personal or professional cause.

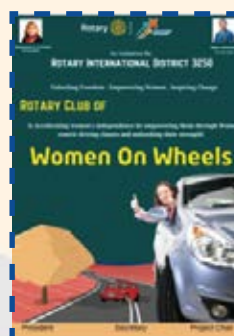
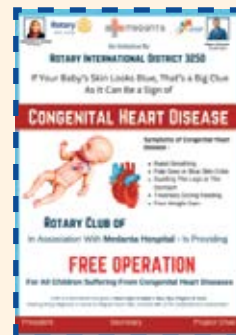
Sangkoo Yun

We urge the Administration to take this up at the highest levels possible and announce what can be done immediately, to bring solace to the family and Society.


