Minneapolis, Minnesota, USA, to host 2028 Rotary International Convention

Rotary has announced that Minneapolis, Minnesota, USA, will host its convention in 2028.

The Rotary International Convention welcomes tens of thousands of members and their friends and family each year from around the world. Rotary and Rotaract clubs in the Twin Cities of Minneapolis and St. Paul are excited to showcase their beautiful metropolitan area and the incredible community service projects they have underway.

The Rotary International Board initially selected Minneapolis to host the convention in 2029. The change to 2028, with the convention occurring 27-31 May, gives members a chance to explore an additional location in 2029 before Rotary's 125th anniversary convention in Chicago, Illinois, USA, in 2030. A replacement host city for 2029 has not yet been chosen.

For the 16th consecutive year, The Rotary Foundation has received the highest rating — four stars — from [Charity Navigator](#), an independent evaluator of charities in the U.S.

The Foundation earned the recognition for adhering to sector best practices and executing its mission in a financially efficient way, demonstrating both strong financial health and commitment to accountability and transparency.

“We are delighted to provide the Rotary Foundation with third-party accreditation that validates their operational excellence,” said Michael Thatcher, president and CEO of Charity Navigator. “The Four-Star Rating is the highest possible rating an organization can achieve. Charity Navigator analyses nonprofit performance based on four key indicators, referred to as beacons. Currently, nonprofits can earn scores for the impact and results, accountability and finance, culture and communities, and leadership and adaptability.

Rotary Club Models

Type of Club	Description
E-Club	: A Rotary club that meets primarily online
Passport Club	: A Rotary club that allows members to attend other Rotary club meetings as long as they attend a specified number of meetings in their own club each year
Corporate Club	: A club whose members tend to work for the same employer
Cause-Based Club	: A club whose members are passionate about a particular cause and focus their service efforts in that area
Alumni Club	: A club whose members are former Rotary program participants (Exchange students, volunteers, Rotary Scholars) or Rotary Foundation program participants
Satellite Club	: A Rotary club sponsored by a traditional club but with its own meetings, projects, bylaws, and board
Rotaract Club	: A club with members who are young adults 18+. Some Rotaract clubs are based on University campuses and some are based in the community.
