Mrinalini Mazumdar at Rotary Sadan on 3 Dec. 2024

Mrinalini's presentation addressed the crucial role of the performing arts in driving social change and the urgent need to address gender-based violence (GBV) within the sector. In performing arts, where physical expression is central and mentorship often creates close power dynamics, artists — especially women — face unique vulnerabilities and exploitation. The discussion explored how traditional mentorship models, while essential to training, can unintentionally foster environments where exploitation occurs. She tellingly drew a parallel from school education where even parents don't call out a teacher's misdemeanours. India's legal frameworks are adapting to better protect artists and promote safer spaces but there's a long way to go on that. Laws and statutes are available, and cases of misuse are not unknown. A millennial, she used the demographic's lexicon of 'cancel culture' that attends typically on the victim in our patriarchal society.
