Our congratulations extend to everyone involved for orchestrating an unforgettable experience.





#### City's 11 pollution hot spots listed



Kolkata: Following complaints on Kolkata's deteriorating air quality, the Kolkata Municipal Corporation (KMC) has identified as many as 11 pollution hot spots in the city and started carrying out intensive mitigation measures to clean up the air.

Based on the hyper-local air quality data the identified pollution hotspots are at BT Road (from Tala to Sinthi More), DH Road - from St Thomas to Taratala and Taratala to Behala Chowrasta - Hazra Intersection, Park Circus 7 point crossing, Shyambazar 5 point crossing, Burrabazar-Posta, Strand Road, Cossipore Road, Khanna Cinema and its adjacent areas, Moulali and Ultadanga crossing, among others.

This comes at a time when the city has been grappling with 'poor' air quality index (AQI: 201-300) with a significant rise in cases of breathing distress.

KMC has also identified three key sources of air pollution - vehicular emission, construction & demolition dust and roaddust resuspension. Thankfully, we have the Good Oxygen for you.


