On **14th November 2023**, based upon the **Eye Checkup Camp** that was held on **5th November**, 80 nos. spectacles were distributed to patients.







# **Medical Oxygen Cylinders Bansai Kanaipur Babsayee**



### Kolkata most polluted, beats Delhi



Kolkata: According to a report in a renowned news portal, Kolkata was the most polluted metro in the country a day before Diwali, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) showed.

Although both Kolkata and Delhi had "poor" air quality from 4pm on Friday to 4pm on Saturday, Kolkata's air quality index (AQI) value was 269

compared to Delhi's 225.

Chennai was third with an AQI of 115 and Mumbai was fourth with 90. Bangalore and Hyderabad had AQI levels 90 and 94, respectively.

A scientist at the Bose Institute predicted that Kolkata's air quality is likely to remain "around 200-230 (poor)" during Diwali.
